The purpose of the Hualalai 'Ohana Foundation Honor Roll Award is to recognize the outstanding students of the Hualalai 'Ohana. Employees may be full-time, part-time, or casual, but must have passed their 90-day probation period in order to be eligible for the Honor Roll Award, and the student must be:

- **the employee's child, legal step-child or legally adopted child;**
- **have completed the 6th through 12th grade of a;**
- **Hawaii private, public, or charter school (home-schooling is not eligible); and**
- **meet a final minimum GPA of 3.0 or B + for 2017-2018 school year.**

The Hualalai 'Ohana Foundation Board of Directors has established the Honor Roll Award amounts as:

- **\$150.00 for students in 6th - 8th grades and;**
- **\$250.00 for students in 9th - 12th grades**

To apply, please submit your child's report card along with the attached Enrollment Form by **Friday, June 29, 2018.**

The award ceremony is scheduled for **Sunday, July 29th at 10:00am** in the Four Seasons Ballroom. In addition, all awardees that attend the award ceremony will be entered to win a brand, new MacBook Pro or iPad. *Must be present to win (prior year winning households are ineligible).*
