Since August 2020, the Hualālai 'Ohana Foundation has distributed 193 'Ohana@Home Technology for Education awards to families like Rayna's. This means 193 families can breathe a little easier knowing their children will not miss out on lessons or be intimidated by the rapid transition to remote learning.

Because of you, Hualālai Resort employees, contractors, service providers and vendors have received awards ranging from \$500-\$800 to help provide for their families' at-home remote learning through the pandemic. Thank you for pulling together to make it possible to care for others when help was needed, so we could all help families have a sense of stability amid a lot of uncertainty.

Adjusting to new life on Molokai in the middle of a pandemic required many changes for the family, including Rayna's son Duke who had to transition to an online classroom for school. But without a computer and router, the idea of distance learning wasn't just intimidating, it was stressful. Thanks to the generosity of donors like you, and a pledge commitment from the Hualālai Resort ownership, we were able to help make the transition to remote learning at home easier for a busy mom and her family through an 'Ohana@Home Technology for Education award.

I've been on furlough now for over 6 months. We had no idea that we would face so many challenges and sacrifices. Our family vehicle was recently repossessed and our monthly bills are payments behind. Although we are facing financial hardships, we still find many reasons to smile. 'Ohana Impact

The following are just a few examples of how your support can make a lasting difference....

YOUR GIFT OF

\$750	will provide the child of a Hualālai 'ohana employee to participate in an off-island learning program, tutoring or learning opportunity, enriching lives and creating a brighter future.
\$1,500	will provide support for a meritorious college student working over the summer months with a match on their summer employment earnings, encouraging them on their academic journey so they can have more time to focus on their studies.
\$3,000	will provide support for the unexpected serious medical situations that arise for families and individuals during times of urgent medical, dental or surgical need, making it easier for them to return to work and life at Hualālai.
\$3,500	will provide technology for remote learning and education for 7 keiki or adult learners, defray costs of purchasing a computer, printer, router or software.
\$7,500	will provide a bright, healthy start for Hawaiʻi's keiki, making it possible for the child of a Hualālai Resort employee to receive private Preschool or K12 education here in Hawaiʻi. Average need per year = 60 awards of \$4,000.
\$15,000	will support 10 Academic Merit awards of \$1,500 each for a meritorious college student performing well in school and pursuing dreams of higher education achievement. Average need is 15 per year.
\$25,000	will provide merit-based cash awards of \$150 to \$250 to 115 students who have earned a spot on the Honor Roll for the year.
\$35,000	will help build a bright future through funding for skills/vocational training and coursework opportunities. Average need = 72 awards per year (48 adults, 24 children). Average award \$500. Common coursework includes summer art and science programs, security guard certificates, fitness and wellness, computer programming and financial literacy courses.
\$50,000	will provide 40 scholarships for students pursuing higher education at an in-state or out-of- state college. Average need is 40 scholarships per year. Average award amount is \$1500
