safeguarding well-being

CenClub's top priority is the safety and well-being of our residents.

CenClub's top priority is the safety and wellbeing of our residents. As our building operations continue to grow, the safety and security of the recreation properties becomes more imperative. Our focus is on the residents, and securing the future of CVE.

This past year, our biggest addition to the security infrastructure of the recreation properties has been the new contracted services through Allied Universal. We have improved standards at all security checkpoints, in addition to paramedic treatment and response time.

Along with the security contract, we have implemented a rover, to police the satellite pools, courts, and parking lots of the recreation properties. This officer is tasked with regulating pool and court rules, in addition to reporting on disturbances and parking violations.



safeguarding well-being

With hundreds of acres of property to manage, we have made a significant effort to grow our surveillance footprint year after year.

This year we added rooftop High definition PTZ cameras on the roof of the clubhouse to capture high traffic areas around the building and sporting complex. We also have added cameras around the perimeter of the diner, Richmond Tennis courts, and the parking lot pickleball courts. These additions are a great extension of our surveillance system, and are ensuring the safety and security of the community.

We are excited to report that Re-Validation has been completed with a grand total of just under 16,000 ID's Re-validated since the beginning of this campaign. Now that residents are using these newly issued IDs, we have been able to prevent unauthorized individuals from accessing the clubhouse, ensuring that residents and their guests are safe. Custom prompts have been added to "Revoked" and "Invalid" IDs, alerting security guards of potential issues.



safeguarding well-being



To keep residents safe during projects and maintenance, CenClub has purchased safety rope stanchions. These keep job sites clean without the use of unattractive caution tape. These weighted stanchions are lockable and compliment the aesthetic of our beautiful facilities.

This year, CenClub purchased a new Paramedic case, and upgraded its contents to include more first aid equipment. This case is organized with dividers and provides easier access during emergencies. The case is also extremely durable and weather proof, eliminating the need to replace bags from the wear and tear of daily patrol.





Near the parking lot pickleball complex, we have installed a new speed table and paver crosswalk to offer a safer passage for pedestrians to and from these facilities. In addition to the added safety of this roadwork, it makes the area more appealing, connecting the parking lot courts to the rest of the clubhouse amenities.



We understand the importance of service

Here at CenClub we understand the importance of Service. As a pinnacle part of your active lifestyle, the clubhouse supplies many services and amenities that residents rely on. Our quality of service that we provide to the community continues to grow, as we expand the resident experiences offered through CenClub.

The offices at the Clubhouse serve the entire community in many ways. This past summer, the administration, ticket, and staff offices received new carpet and baseboards. In addition to the new flooring, the offices underwent improvements in function and organization. We are always excited to help residents, providing quality service within all of the CenClub offices.

improving service

Every year we take part in Toys-for-Tots as a way to serve our wonderful community. The holiday spirit this past year has grown, and residents continue to take part in this impactful campaign. We are excited to announce that we have officially beat the record from years past. Residents have been very generous, and this year the US Marine Corp. picked up 525 toys! CenClub is proud to be a part of such a grand gesture of community service.

This year the restaurant on property received a face lift. Old Florida Café is now the Century Diner, a welcoming and fun retro-themed diner. Along with a colorful paint pallet, and new décor, the diner received brand new tables and booths to fit the theme and increase capacity. In addition to aesthetic upgrades, the menu has grown with some amazing specials and extras.







building for the future

Always improving your amenities

After a year of planning and engineering, the control upgrades in the Party Room and GP-A are complete. Residents will find it much easier to control the audio and video equipment in these spaces. Touch panels have been added with DVD player controls, and an HDMI input makes it easy for residents to display their own presentations. Microphone and input volume controls are simple, allowing residents to easily manage



For years, the drainage in the back parking lot area has been problematic. The slope of the old golf course causes runoff to accumulate near a strip of parking spaces. This was very inconvenient for residents who park in these spaces, forcing them to walk through large puddles during or after a rain shower. This year we have installed a drain system in this area to allow water to properly drain into the city storm sewer. This has already helped residents in keeping them safe and dry while walking through the parking lot.

Billiards has always been a popular activity at the Clubhouse, and this past year we have upgraded the entire space. New wall paneling and tables have been added, tailored to help players hold cues and belongings while playing! Light fixtures have been upgraded, and cue lockers were custom built for the billiards club. A very special thank you to our in house master carpenter and resident, Jerry Moll, for his amazing talents and efforts to transform this space.

The landscaping has been improved throughout the recreation property. We have replaced thinning hedges and declining shrubbery with lush, native plants that thrive in the South Florida elements. Areas like the Ashby pool, outdoor pool, restaurant patio, and the walking path behind the clubhouse are now flourishing with updated plant beds and trees that will continue to grow year after year.

CenClub is continuing to transform around the needs of our residents

We have improved the flood lights for the Sylvester Palms lining Century Blvd in front of the clubhouse parking lot, along with replacing the Wifi Color changing LED lights on the cupola, and around the putting course. These new lights are durable and add great ambiance to these areas.



The Clay Studio is a popular amenity and is especially busy during our scheduled class sessions. Our kilns have been well maintained for more than 20 years. Custom made elements have been replaced in the kilns this year, and electrical connections have been upgraded.

The Singing Pumpkins returned this year with a new set of smash hits including the Sanderson Sisters from Hocus Pocus. This display has become a CVE tradition and the playlist continues to grow year after year.

More is being added to the building operations, and residents are more active than ever before

Our class and events schedule fills our meeting spaces each year, and the need for equipment is growing. This past year we mounted whiteboards in our small meeting rooms, to eliminate the need of additional setup. These boards are glass and magnetic, providing the spaces with functionality and a clean look.

We have made improvements to our online portal to help residents streamline their point-of-sale process. More How To videos have been made for residents to reference, and tips have been posted on the checkout pages.

maintenance and improvements



The maintenance team has had another busy year.

The year brough many improvements and repairs. Here are some notable accomplishments from 2023.

The pool house at Markham has received a new roof.

Lighting panels were upgraded to LED fixtures throughout the clubhouse. A total of 76 panels were replaced.

New exhaust fans were installed in the indoor pool. Noise was reduced and circulation was improved.

A major improvement this year has been the replacing of the Billiards and Art Studio A/C Units. These units were nearly original to the building.

The pools at CVE continue to grow in popularity as an amenity within the village.

Preventative maintenance and pressure cleaning were performed across the satellite pools.

All pool decks were resealed to protect the pavers from the elements, helping preserve their color and reduce erosion.

New ladder treads were installed on all pools throughout the community, making it easier to grip the steps while exiting the water.

The Berkshire and Newport Pools were completely resurfaced, and brand new pavers were laid on the Newport and Westbury pool decks.



major projects



Richmond Pool Renovation

Progress for the Richmond pool renovation is complete. The pool has been completely redesigned with residents in mind. A zeropoint entrance has been added to the design for ease of access for residents that may need it. Junior Olympic lap lanes were incorporated on one side of the pool for residents to exercise, and a lounging area with seating and jets have been added to the middle.

In addition to the exciting new outline and features of the pool itself, the pool deck has also been reimagined. New pavers were installed to compliment the modern aesthetic, and pool furniture added throughout the deck. Three beautiful Sylvester palms have been incorporated into the pool deck design, providing natural shade to the surrounding chairs and tables. The canopy was replaced with a Hurricane rated shelter complete with recessed lighting and fans for cooling off.





Finally, the bathrooms were completely remodeled to complete the new design, and incorporates the pool and pool deck designs tying everything together.

As our community's needs continue to grow, this pool has something for everyone!

major projects



Clubhouse Paver Pathway

This summer, the roadway running through the sports complex in the back of the clubhouse was replaced with a beautiful paver pathway and promenade. These pavers connect all areas of the complex, and add beauty to the property. Centering the pavers are newly planted Sylvester Palms and triple foxtail palms to add greenery to the area. These trees are lit at night to add even more aesthetic appeal.

Additional Pickleball Courts

Our residents are always active, and our facilities are growing to meet their needs. After a year of planning and permitting, CenClub is breaking ground on the Parking lot pickleball complex, bringing the total pickleball courts in the village to 18 courts. This project is an exciting addition to the amenities here, providing our resident athletes with more time to play during the busy season.




New Ballet Barres

Building Automation

Over the next year, we plan to complete the entirety of the building automation systems throughout the recreation properties. Through GulfStream controls and AutomatedLogic, the CenClub facilities will be fully automated and controllable. Lighting circuits to new areas such as the Putting Course area will be added to this project, all regulated online and via text notification. We are excited to complete this huge project, adding efficiency and control to the rest of the property.

The roof of the clubhouse has been repaired in countless areas over the years. Even with these repairs, water still finds a way into our beloved building. This year the Clubhouse will be receiving a new roof to fortify the protection against the storms and weather the South Florida climate brings. Combined with the new windows from last year, this new improvement will significantly help preserve our facilities for years to come.

Clubhouse Outdoor Pool

Just like Richmond, the clubhouse pool will be undergoing renovations next year. The pool will be transformed to a resort-style amenity, with new features and a beautiful pool deck. We are excited to start this project, and continue the growing improvements of the village.

This year we will be finishing the construction of the new Handball and Racquetball Area. Residents will be able to check out equipment from the staff office for this facility, adding even more to the growing list of activities at the Clubhouse. We have already broken ground on this new facility, and we can't wait to open up the court for residents to use.

2023-2024 budget

At CenClub, we prioritize the responsibility of allocating your monthly recreation payments. Our goal is always to enhance and grow amenities for our residents. We keep our focus on introducing new facilities and amenities, elevating the quality of life, and fortifying reserves for the future of CVE. Here's a look at the CenClub Recreation Management Budget for the fiscal year 2023–2024.

Income

CenClub's income is comprised of monthly recreation fees, and activity revenue such as classes and ticket sales. We are proud to say that the CenClub coupon hasn't changed, and remains the lowest of the three payments required by owners. Next year, just under \$11 million will be allocated towards maintaining the beauty of the recreation facilities, and growing the amenities and services offered through CenClub.


