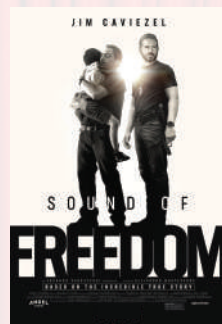

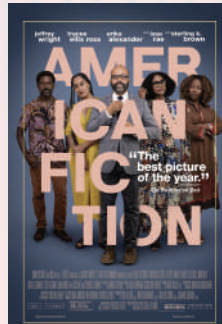


## SOUND OF FREEDOM

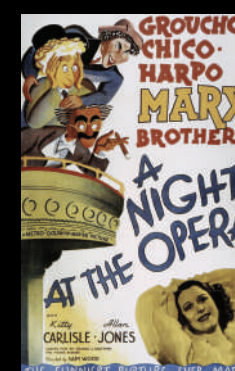
