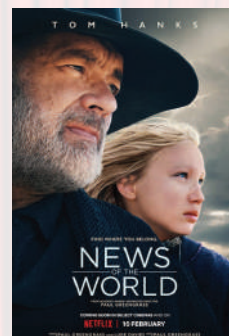

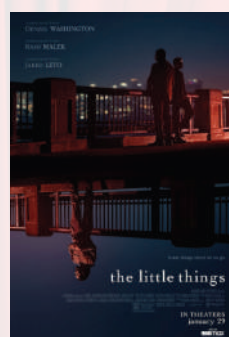


### SUPERNOVA

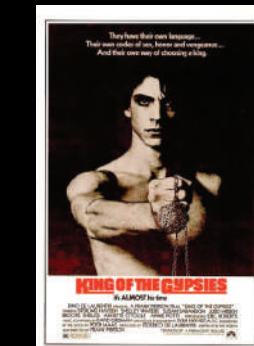
