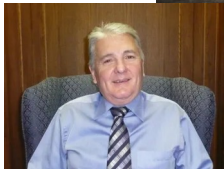
Prince Albert and Area Community Foundation

- Research

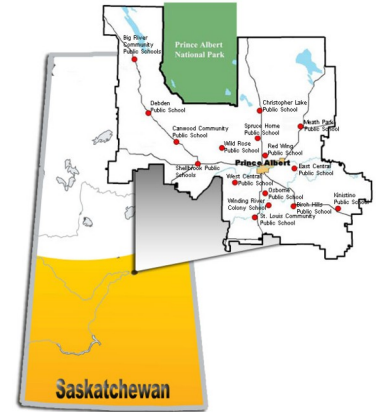
The PAACF also participates in awarding various scholarships to High School and Post-Secondary students.
