Church Service Format

WELCOME: "Come and hear, all who fear God, and I will tell of what He has done for my soul." Announcements are made, prayer requests are taken, and any person desiring to briefly share what God is doing in their life is free to do so.

PRAYER: "I urge that entreaties and prayers, petitions and thanksgivings, be made on behalf of all men ..." Prayers are made for the salvation of others, missions, believers suffering persecution, and needs in general.

SINGING: "Praise the Lord! Sing to the Lord a new song, and His praise in the congregation of saints." Traditional and/or contemporary songs are sung, accompanied by flowing, acoustical guitar music.

TEACHING: "... give attention to the public reading of Scripture, to exhortation and teaching ... Preach the word." A verse-by-verse message is given from the word of God, the Bible.

INTROSPECTION: "Prove yourselves to be doers of the word, and not hearers only ..." Following the message there is a moment of silence so all can prayerfully determine how to make application of God's word.

FELLOWSHIP: "... *let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds.*" All are encouraged to build one-another up in their faith by praying for one another, sharing what God is doing in their lives, and engaging in other forms of Christian charity. The Bible is God's written revelation to man, inspired by the Holy Spirit and the only infallible rule of faith and practice.

There is one God existing eternally as a trinity: God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.

Man was originally created in the image of God but rebelled and sinned. As a result all people are sinners and liable to God's judgment.

Jesus Christ was born of a virgin, lived a sinless life, performed miracles, died a substitutionary and sacrificial death for the sins of the world, rose bodily from the dead, ascended into heaven, and will personally return to judge the living and dead and establish His kingdom.

All who trust in Christ's finished work on the cross are saved from God's judgment. They are forgiven of their sins and also inwardly transformed by the Holy Spirit thereby making a continuing life of sin unnatural.

Salvation is by grace through faith in Christ. Those who put their faith in Christ inherit everlasting life, while those who reject Christ receive everlasting punishment.

The church consist of all those who have put their faith in Christ, and is not limited to any single local church, denomination or association of churches.
