

The City of Savannah's Parking Services and the MPC completed a survey and parking study within the boundaries of Gaston Street (north), Park Avenue (south), Habersham Street (east), and Drayton Street (west). The growth and development in this area has increased, incidentally increasing the residential and visitor population in the area. SCAD has also opened a student residential hall for approximately 650+ students.

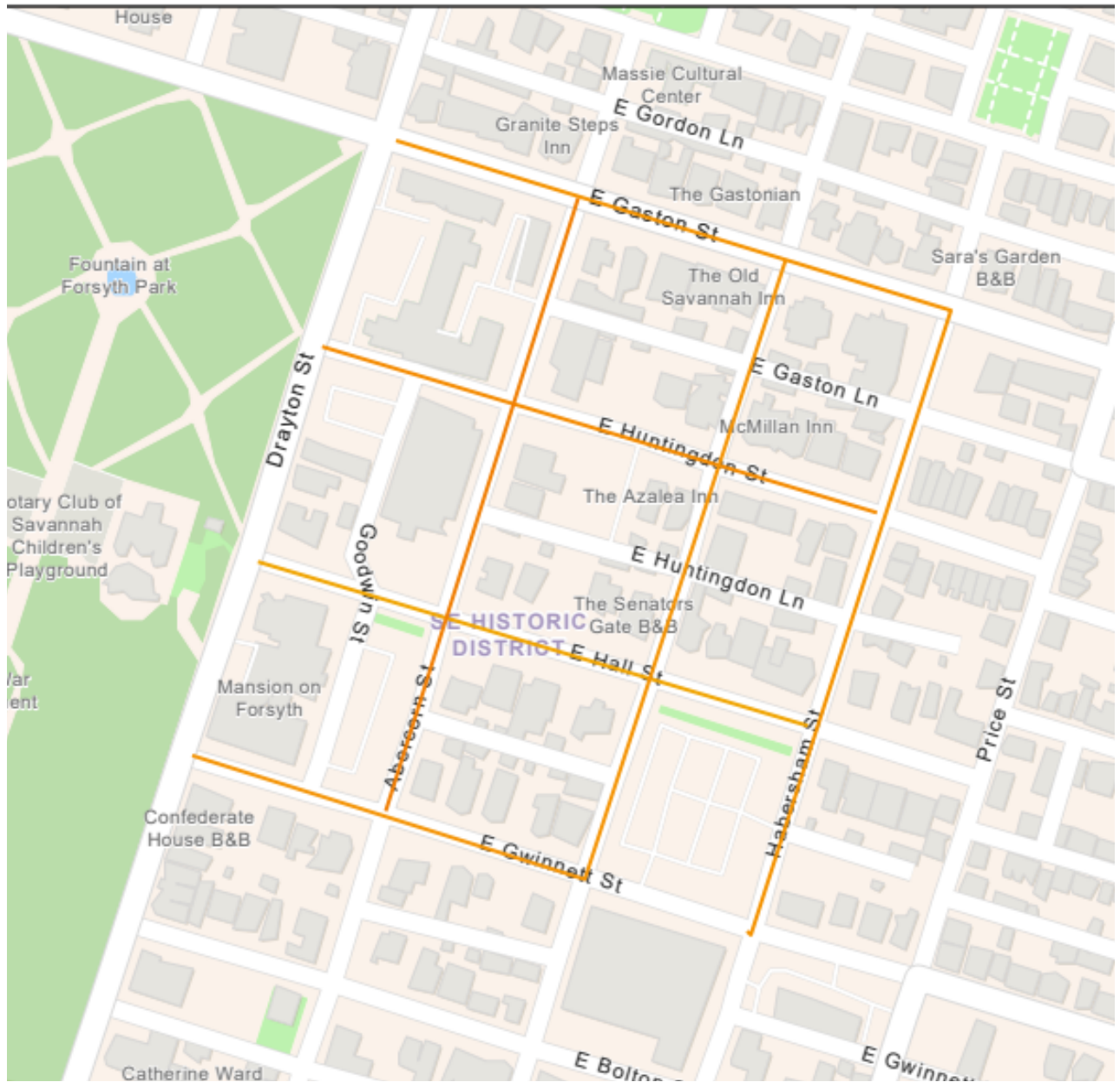
Residents within the boundaries noted above have asked the City to review the parking within this area and propose ways to regulate the current and future increase in parking demands. After reviewing the study completed by the MPC, the City is proposing the following regulations within the boundaries of Gaston St. (north), Gwinnett St (south), Habersham St (east), & Drayton St (west). The area of the proposed regulation is shown on the maps below.



No changes to the study area

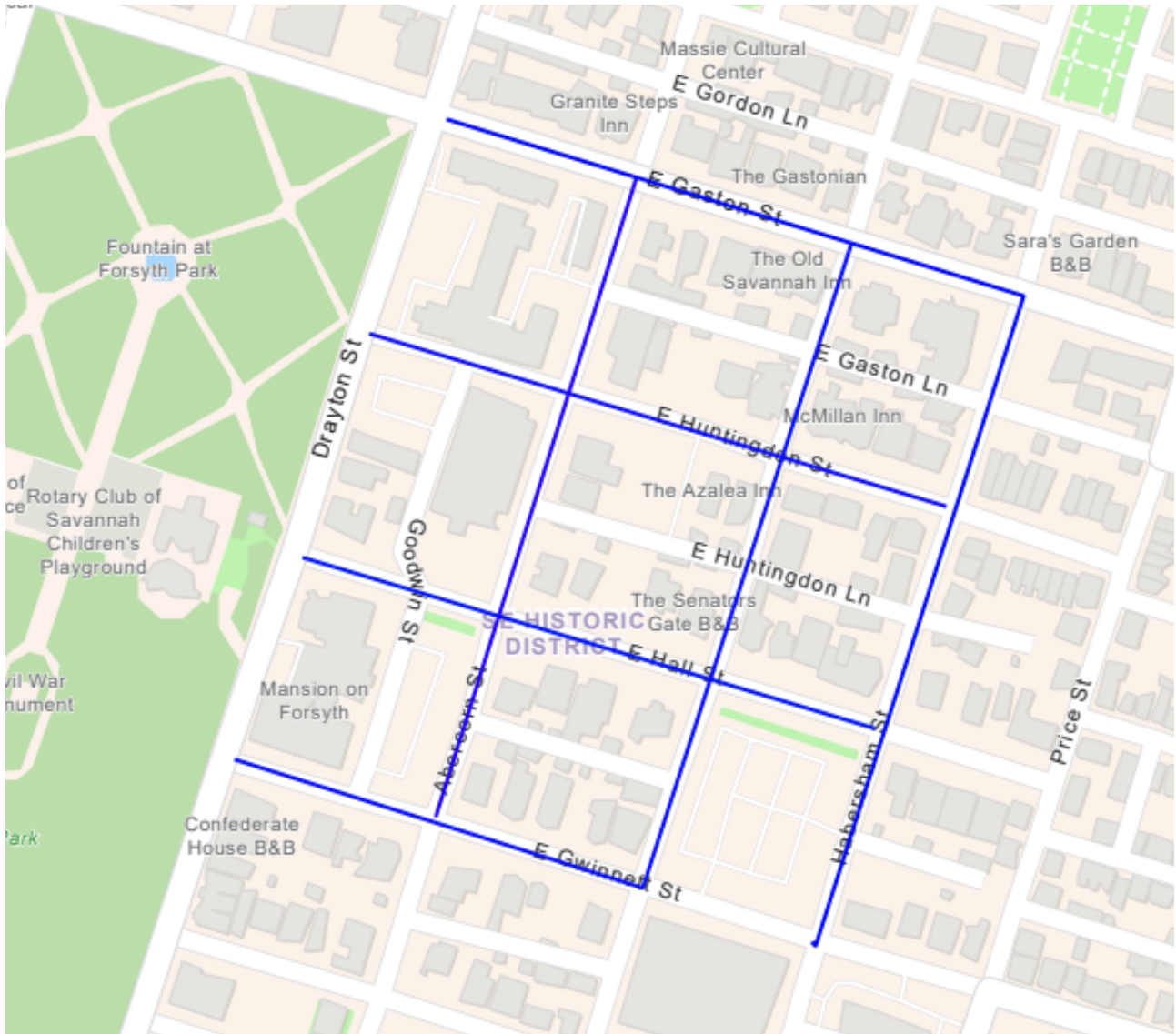


Unregulated delineated parking spaces will be added to the streets. This could result in a loss of available parking to adhere to traffic laws regarding curbs/sidewalks.



Regulated Pay Stations with a 2-hour limit
