Historical Reflections – 1925 to 2025

Founding & Purpose

In 1925, a visionary group of church ushers came together with a shared mission: to elevate the ministry of ushering through excellence, unity, and spiritual purpose. Thus, the Durham Ushers Union (DUU) was born—an interdenominational fellowship committed to dignified service and community uplift.

Membership included ushers and first aid auxiliaries from churches across Durham and the surrounding areas. All members automatically become part of the state-level affiliate, the Interdenominational Ushers Association of North Carolina, Inc. (IUA), also established in 1925. There were as many as twenty-two churches that were members of the Union.

The Union's founding goals were steadfast:

☐ Establish and maintain high standards for the usher and first aid ministry

- Promote spiritual growth, education, and outreach

Foster fellowship among member churches

Among DUU's founding members was **Claude Calvin Cobb, Sr.**, a devoted usher from Mt. Vernon Baptist Church, located at 1007 S. Roxboro Street in Durham. His legacy continues to inspire generations of ushers.

Growth & Impact

Over the past century, DIUU has fulfilled its mission with distinction:

- Awarded over **\$100,000 in educational scholarships.**

Participated in the annual Interdenomination-

al Ministerial Alliance of Durham and Vicinity activities

Emancipation; Martin Luther King services; Durham City Wide revivals and the Last 7 sayings.

- Prepare and deliver thanksgiving baskets to the sick and shut-in ushers.
- Participated in funeral services for Durham Interdenominational Ushers Union members.

- Participated annually in the four **Durham Rescue Mission community events**.
- Volunteered at the **local food bank**.
- Sponsored **clothing drives and school supply distributions**.
- Hosted **health workshops** for ushers and the community.

Supported annual youth oratorical, essay, and talent competitions through DIUU and IUA.

The Union actively participated in IUA's mid-year and annual sessions, contributed to community events across North Carolina, and celebrated fellowship through its annual Fun Day.

Originally governed by an Advisory Board, the Union transitioned to a **Board of Directors in 2017** upon becoming a 501(c)(3) nonprofit. At that time, the name was officially changed to the **Durham Interdenominational Ushers Union (DIUU)**.

BRIEF HISTORY OF *Charles Bruce Noel*

Mr. Noel was a devoted member of White Rock Baptist Church for many years, and he was a member of the Senior Usher Board. Mr. Noel was very dedicated to his mission as an Usher, always being there doing what he was assigned to do. His relentless devotion to serving as an Usher set an example for us all.

The Durham Ushers Union has been meeting at White Rock since its beginning on Monday night after the 3rd Sunday. You could count on Mr. Noel to be there. He served on many committees and programs during those years. In the years that Mr. Charles Noel served the Union, there was a program each month and he was always there. The Durham Ushers Union honored him and gave him a silver tray and named him "Mr. Durham Ushers Union."

When Charles Noel passed away, it was decided that there should be a way that the Durham Ushers Union could honor such a devoted and committed usher. He was always willing and did whatever, when it came to ushering and training and developing other ushers.

Mr. Noel died February 1962. A committee was formed and decided to honor him by having a scholarship in his name. The Scholarship Program started the 2nd Sunday in March 1963, and has continued.

He was the father of a daughter, Margaret Noel Venters, a son, Charles Brint Noel, 2 grandchildren and 1 great grandchild.

Durham Ushers Union has an annual fundraiser to generate funds so that we can award scholarships to scholars like you in order to remember the love, commitment and devotion that Mr. Noel exemplified as an Usher. We celebrate him today by awarding you this scholarship.
