Flare Night is an annual tradition on Lake Orion. Residents simultaneously light flares at 10 p.m. around the shoreline of the lake casting a red glow on the water. The Rotarians started Flare Night on Lake Orion in 1945 as a commemoration of the end of WWII. The Lake Orion Lions Club has helped continue the Flare Night tradition for decades and uses the flare sale proceeds as a fundraiser in their mission to prevent blindness.
