



Using LibraWATCH to upgrade LibraPRO firmware

Follow the procedure below


1. Download and install the LibraWATCH program from www.kinesys.co.uk/support/item/librawatch you need to be running LibraWATCH V3.1.50 or higher.
2. Download the latest firmware file (Currently z_LIBRAPRO-v2.12.kfi) from www.kinesys.co.uk/support/item/librapro
3. Ensure that you know what IP address the LibraPRO is configured to use (For this example we will assume it is configured to use its default address 192.168.18.41)
4. Run LibraWATCH and choose to connect to 192.168.18.41. If LibraPRO is running V1.xx software you will see a message similar to that shown below



5. If .kfi file is located in a zip (compressed folder). Move the .kfi file into a regular folder before continuing.
6. Drag and drop the kfi file selected in step 2 onto the LibraWATCH window. You should then see an uploading message similar to this on the screen.



7. When the upload of the firmware is finished you will be prompted with a message similar to that shown below



8. Power cycle the LibraPRO and it will upgrade the firmware and start running.
9. Confirm the LibraPRO is running the correct version of firmware by power cycling it again and observing its display during power up, or by checking the config menu which will show which version of firmware is being run on the device.
