GUIDELINES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANTS FOR THE 2022 ADVANCED NATIONAL TRAIN THE TRAINERS COURSE

INTRODUCTION

The Advanced National Train The Trainers Course is training for National Training Officers to enable them gain certification as Advanced National Training Officers.

In view of the fact that there are limited spaces for intending trainees and the need to ensure quality representation of the Lagos State Council at the training, it therefore, necessary to put in place best practices that will ensure fairness, transparency and demonstration of competence of the BB work by applicants in the selection. It is pertinent to note, that the guidelines, will apply to all applicants irrespective of their affiliations.

GUIDELINES

Intending applicants MUST

- 1. be residentially qualified. In other words, he/she must have met the mandatory number of years after graduation as a National Training Officer (NTO);
- 2. Write the Competency test to be conducted by the State Council at a specified Date, Venue and Time. Failure to write the test under any guise will amount to automatic disqualification.
- 3. Submit an application for sponsorship to the course. The application should be addressed and to the Office of the Secretary Organiser, BBN-LSC and submitted Online https://boysbrigadelagos.com/training not later than **Friday June 24, 2022.** Photocopies of Certificates for attendance at the Advanced National Train-The- Trainers Course, State Training Officers Course, Brigade School and Basic Officers Courses must be attached to the application;
- 4. Submit a training <u>Proposal for the Seniors choosing a theme of your choice</u>. The proposal should be submitted alongside the application;
- 5. Possess requisite academic qualification not lower than a university degree or its equivalent; and
- 6. be prepared to attend an oral interview.

PARAMETERS FOR ASSESSMENT

To be recommended and qualified for the training, the applicant MUST score at least a total of aggregate of 80 (Eighty) points as follows:
