**GUIDELINES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANTS FOR THE  
2024 NATIONAL BRIGADE SCHOOL COURSE**

**INTRODUCTION**

The National Brigade School Course is training for Officers to enable them gain certification as completely Trained BB Officers.

In view of the fact that there are limited spaces for intending trainees and the need to ensure quality representation of the Lagos State Council at the training, it therefore, necessary to put in place best practices that will ensure fairness, transparency and demonstration of competence of the BB work by applicants in the selection. It is pertinent to note, that the guidelines, will apply to all applicants irrespective of their affiliations.

**GUIDELINES**

Intending applicants **MUST**

1. be residentially qualified. In other words, he/she must have met the mandatory number of years after completion of Officers Basic IV Training.
2. Submit an application for sponsorship to the Training Course. The application should be addressed and submitted to the Office of the Secretary Organiser, BBN-LSC and submitted Online (<https://boysbrigadelagos.com/brigadeschool>) not later than **Friday October 18, 2024**. *The application should be submitted in MS Word or PDF format.* Scanned Copies of Certificates for attendance at the Officers Basic Courses (I-IV) & Recommendation Letters from the Church and Battalion Council on full participation in activities **MUST** be attached to the application.
3. Submit a **Training Proposal for Companies operating the Junior Section Achievement Scheme**. The proposal should be submitted alongside the application in MS Word or PDF.
4. Write the Online Competency test to be conducted by the State Council at a specified date, venue, and time. Failure to write the test under any guise will amount to automatic disqualification, and
5. Be prepared to attend a Refreshers Course prior to the commencement of The Brigade School.

**PARAMETERS FOR ASSESSMENT**

To be recommended and qualified for the training, the applicant **MUST** score at least a total of aggregate of 70 (seventy) points as follows:

1	Competency Test	60
2	Recommendation from Battalion Council	10
3	Recommendation from Church (Letter signed by Chaplain)	10
4	Performance at Refreshers Course	20
