GUIDELINES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANTS FOR THE 2025 NATIONAL TRAINING OFFICERS COURSE

INTRODUCTION

The National Training Course is training for officers to enable them gain certification as National Training Officers.

In view of the fact that there are limited spaces for intending trainees and the need to ensure quality representation of the Lagos State Council at the training, it therefore, necessary to put in place best practices that will ensure fairness, transparency and demonstration of competence of the BB work by applicants in the selection. It is pertinent to note, that the guidelines, will apply to all applicants irrespective of their affiliations.

GUIDELINES

Intending applicants **MUST**

1. be residentially qualified. In other words, he/she must have met the mandatory number of years after graduation as a State Training Officer (STO);
2. write the Competency test to be conducted by the State Council at a specified date, venue and time. Failure to write the test under any guise will amount to automatic disqualification.
3. Submit an application for sponsorship to the course. The application should be addressed and submitted to the Office of the Secretary Organiser, BBN-LSC and submitted online (<http://boysbrigadelagos.com/training>) not later than **Monday January 13, 2025**. Photocopies of Merit Certificates for attendance at the State Training officers Course, Brigade School and Basic Officers course must be attached to the application;
4. Submit a training Proposal for the Seniors choosing a theme of your choice. The proposal should be submitted alongside the application.
5. Possessing a requisite academic qualification not lower than a university degree or its equivalent will be an added advantage; and
6. Candidates **MUST** be prepared to attend an oral interview and written test at a specified date, venue and time.

PARAMETERS FOR ASSESSMENT

To be recommended and qualified for the training, the applicant **MUST** score at least a total of aggregate of 70 (Seventy) points as follows:

1	Competency Test	50
2	Participation at Battalion Training Courses (T&E Assigned)	10
3	Attendance at Training and Extension Committee Meetings	10
4	Performance at Oral Interview & Exam	30
