DISTRIBUTION OF STAKES

After 35% of entry fees have been deducted for expenses for the Club, the remaining 65% will be divided as follows: 15% Best in Sweepstakes, 10% to Best of Opposite Sex. The remaining 40% will will be known as the Sweepstakes Class Fund and will be divided among dogs and bitches in each age class based on the proportion of that particular class to the total entry.

The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If at the end of the 90 day period the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

SPECIAL RECOGNITION - BOTH EVENTS

Awards of Merit - WSSTC offers a Dark Green Rosette as an Award of Merit after the Best of Breed Competition. The award recognizes up to two outstanding champions, excluding those selected for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Champions of record are the only recipients of this award. The presentation of the Award(s) of Merit is at the judge's discretion and immediately follows the judging of the Best of Breed Competition.

Best Puppy - Following Best of Breed, the winners of the Regular Puppy Dog/Bitch 6-9 mos., Puppy Dog/Bitch 9-12 mos., and Bred By Exhibitor Puppy Dog/Bitch 6-12 mos. (only) will compete for Best Puppy.

Best Bred-By Exhibitor - Following Best Puppy, the winners of the Bred By Exhibitor Puppy Dog/ Bitch and Bred By Exhibitor Adult Dog/Bitch classes (only) will compete for Best Bred-by Exhibitor.

Best Veteran - Following Best Bred By Exhibito, Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch will compete for Best Veteran.

FROM THE NORTH ON I-5 - Take Exit 88, and cross over the Freeway. Continue for Approximately 6 miles. Turn left at the Main Entrance Sign or RV Park Sign.

FROM SOUTH - **North on I-5**. Take Exit 88 and turn right at the bottom of the ramp. Continue for approximately 6 miles. Turn left at the Main Entrance or RV Entrance.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION - BOTH EVENTS

- **NOVICE CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.
- OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.
- MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.
- **NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:** Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second-place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably
 appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of
 the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
