Once I pick off, but the pumps popped up somewhere else. A groomer friend of mine came over and said – oh skin issues like my terrier has! Try this product Zesty Paws Allergy & Immune Bites. It comes in several flavors and can be purchased at Petco, Chewy, and Amazon.com.

I decided to try it. Now, all the bumps are disappearing! If your dog is itchy and its not fleas, I got the lamb flavor which my dog seems to like. It costs \$32/90 chews.

If you are having seasonal allergies or itchy skin on your Scottie, you might try it. It comes in several flavors and costs \$32/90 chews. One chew for a 25 lb. Scottie.

Pumpkin Oat Dog Biscuits

Making your own homemade dog biscuits is economical and easy. They are also better for your dog too, and McGregor will love you for it.

Prep Time: 20 minutes mins
Cook Time: 35 minutes mins
Total Time: 55 minutes mins
Calories: 46 kcal per biscuit

INGREDIENTS

- 2 eggs
- 1/2 cup canned pumpkin
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 2 tablespoons dry milk
- 2 1/2 cups flour (wheat is probably better!)
- Water as needed

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Blend eggs and pumpkin together; add salt, dry milk, and flour.
2. Add water as needed to make the dough somewhat workable.
3. The dough should be dry and stiff, don't be concerned with crumbs being left in the bowl.
4. You will need to mix this with your hands because it is too stiff for an electric mixer.
5. Roll to 1/2-inch thick.
6. Cut into shapes.
7. Place 1" apart on ungreased cookie sheet.
8. Bake for 20 minutes on one side, then turn over and bake another 20 minutes.




