#### 8. COMMITTEE REPORTS

Also offering Regional Cooperative Grants to help regions promote the paso fino. New grant monies in Trail Horse Test Program (\$200), Membership Appreciation Grant (up to \$500) and a new Regional Co-op Advertising and Marketing Grant for professional displays.

#### 9. VISION WORKSHOP

A. Focused on what we can do to continue to promote the breed. Many would like to see the "Ride a Paso" offered at shows. Survey was handed out to delegates to choose importance of a number of ideas, including: ride a paso, open houses, etc.

### 10. FINAL MOTION OF MEETING

The Ocala and Florida regions put forth a motion at the very end of the meeting to provide \$100 to each of the youth (30 at this time) going to Mundial. This total represents an additional \$9,000 out of the 2020 PFHA budget. The motion was met with a massive negative response from all the other regions in attendance, since we had just passed the 2020 PFHA budget earlier.

A motion was made to table this motion, which failed. Attempts were made by many delegates asking Ocala and Florida to first ask for Foundation funds and then come back to the board at the April meeting. The regions response was that April was too late for their needs.

This motion passed with only Ocala and Florida voting for it. All other regions voted no or abstained.
