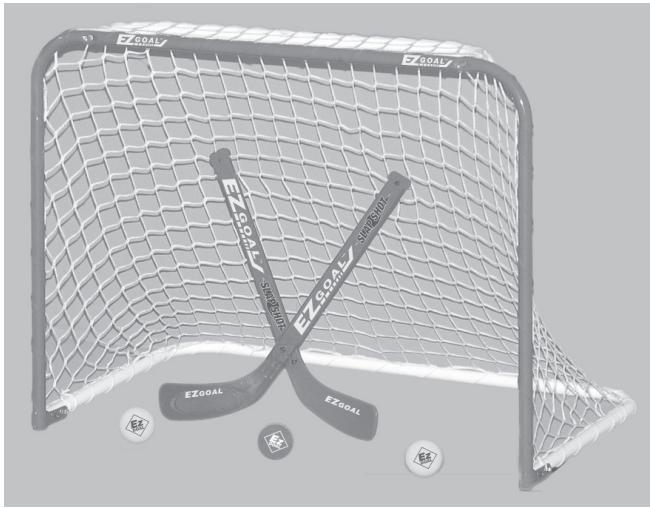

**NOTE: Precision connection will fit snugly, use a rubber mallet or block of wood if needed.**

## 1. Begin assembly

Begin assembly at the base of the goal and work upwards. Follow the diagram. Insert top shelf screws, do not overtighten. Note: Pull pins from both folding legs and unfold. Reinsert pins to lock position prior to assembly.

## 2. Lacing the goal net

Open the goal and put pin in.

Place the sewn part of the net at the top corners, by the top shelf.

*(See Figure 1 & 2).*

Tape or secure the net to the frame. This makes it easy to lace Figure 1 & 2.

The black rope is for the red frame.

White rope is for the white base frame wire.

## 3. Lacing front of goal

The black rope is for the red frame.

Start at the bottom corner.

Loop and tie off net and frame with a double knot at the little hole on the folding section. *(See Figure 3).*

Lace every **OTHER** box of the net. Tie off to the other side of the net to the hole on the folding section. *(See Figure 4).*

## 4. Lacing bottom base

Use the white rope to lace the base. Loop and tie the net and frame together. *(See Figure 3).*

Lace every **OTHER** box of the net. Tie off to the other side. Loop and tie off the net of the frame. *(See Figure 4).*

## 5. Finishing

Cut the extra rope and tie the pins to the net, so it does not get lost. *(See Figure 5).*

## 6. Folding & storage

Pull two pins out, fold the goal and re-insert pins in top hole for storage.

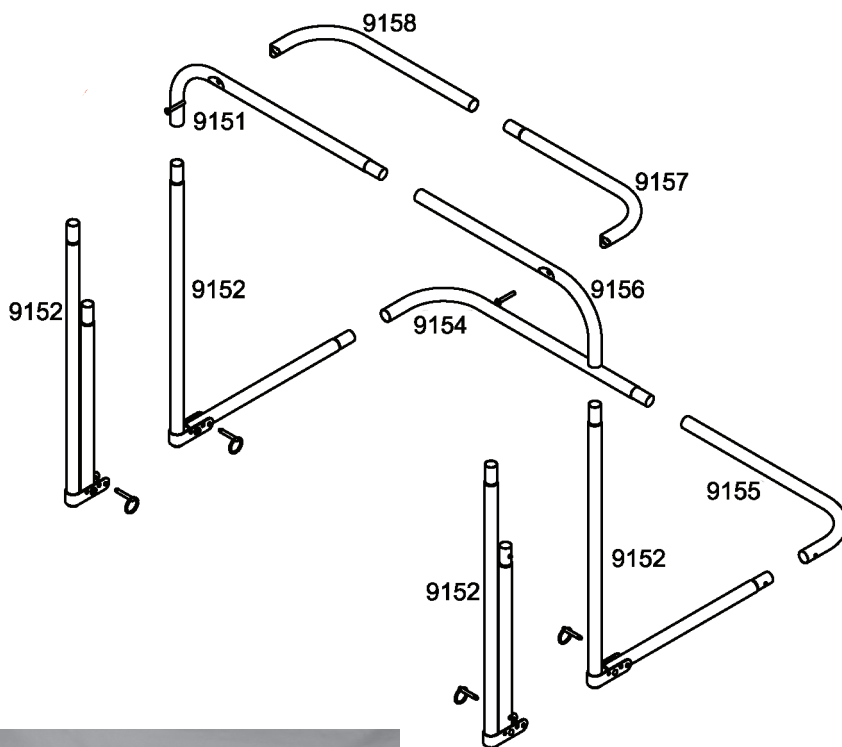

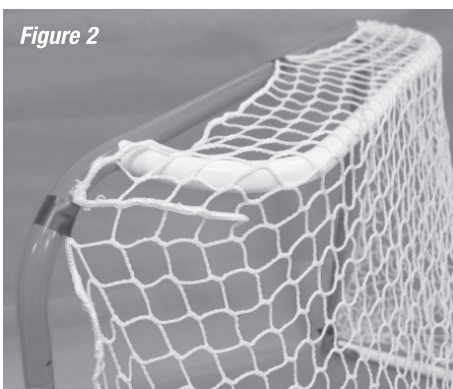

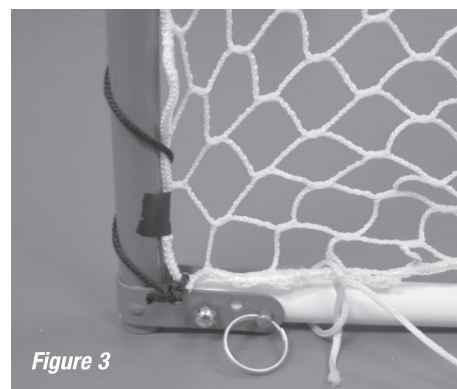

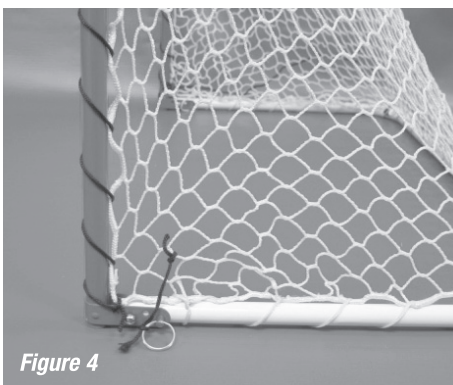

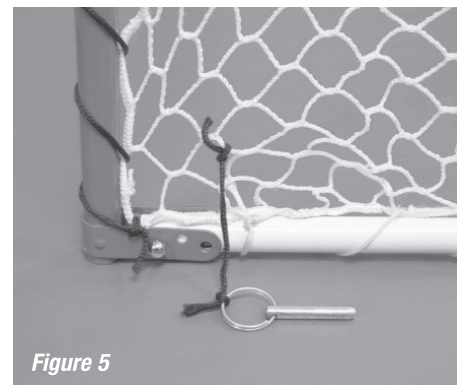
