(57) Abstract :

[0001] The present invention deals with the development of grass airstrips for STOL Aircrafts in Remote Farms and highlights the use of Remote Farms as airstrips. These low-cost airstrips in farms when properly constructed and maintained, can have a degree of safety to meet regulatory requirements, save public funds for construction of airports and add to the economic growth of the farmers in the Remote Areas. It may often be possible to select a suitable ridge or plateau with access to a road or highway which would increase the usefulness and convenience of the airstrip. The terrain in the selected area must be sufficiently flat and without too much grading with natural drainage while gentle slopes are permitted. The airstrip is fenced 100' in width, 3,500' in length and with safe approaches. The fence markers consist of tires painted white hanging on a log every 50' apart. The colour of the trimmed grass airstrip will aid in navigation by the pilot. The end points of the airstrip will be highlighted by l' w
