Elderly Pilgrims Flagged Off Under CM Tirth Yatra Scheme

PGIMER Holds Adolescent Social Media Awareness Session

Chandigarh : A focused awareness initiative promoting safe and responsible social media use among adolescents was held at Saarthak Government Integrated Model Senior Secondary School (GIMSSS), Sector 12A, Panchkula. The session, conducted by a research team from PGIMER, Chandigarh, addressed concerns over excessive social media use, its impact on family relationships, early alcohol exposure, and risky sexual behaviours among adolescents. The programme was part of an Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR)-funded, multi-city cluster randomized controlled trial led by Dr. Tanvi Kiran, Principal Investigator and Associate Professor, Department of Community Medicine and School of Public Health, PGIMER. The study aims to assess social media's influence on adolescents and



develop evidence-based strategies to promote healthy digital behaviours in urban North India. Ms. Divya Sharma, ICMR Research Scientist-II, and the project team delivered the one-hour session to 113 students through interactive presentations and poster discussions, encouraging adolescents to reflect on their digital habits. Three core themes were addressed: the impact of social media on child-family relationships, strategies to limit excessive screen time, the influence of social media on adolescent alcohol consumption,

and risks associated with sexualised online content and cyber intimacy. Practical strategies such as content filtering, screen-time limits, real-life engagement, and digital responsibility were highlighted. Educational posters developed by the PGIMER team were handed to the school administration and installed in classrooms to reinforce safe digital practices. Students actively participated in discussions, sharing experiences and seeking guidance, reflecting high engagement and empowerment to make informed online decisions. The session was supported by school principal Ms. Renu Bala and Dr. Sandhya, PGT Psychology. The initiative provides a scalable model to promote adolescent health and responsible digital behaviour amid rising social media exposure.

Neighbor Kills Man Over Suspected Affair Police Hunt Accused

Moga : A man was shot dead in Kailan village, under the Dharamkot police station area, following a personal dispute reportedly arising from suspicion of an illicit relationship. The deceased, Bharpur Singh, was killed by his neighbor, Inderjit Singh alias Soni, who allegedly suspected his wife of having a relationship with Bharpur. Police have registered a case and launched a search for the accused, who remains at large. According to reports, the incident took place yesterday evening around 7 p.m. Inderjit Singh, armed with a licensed 32-bore revolver, reportedly shot Bharpur Singh in the head, killing him on the spot. Local sources say the accused was intoxicated at the time of the shooting, which escalated from ongoing tension between the two men. Following the incident, police teams from Dharamkot and nearby areas arrived at the scene to secure



the area and collect evidence. Senior officers confirmed that the accused had a history of personal disputes with the victim, and the feud had reportedly intensified in recent weeks over alleged suspicions regarding the accused's spouse. The victim's family and villagers expressed shock and grief over the sudden violence, calling for immediate action against the perpetrator. Law enforcement officials stated that a detailed investigation is underway, including verification of witness

statements, examination of the weapon used, and tracing the movements of the accused. Police have urged the public to remain calm and provide any information that may help in apprehending the suspect. Meanwhile, local authorities are working to ensure the safety of the community and prevent further incidents arising from personal disputes. The case highlights concerns over domestic tensions and personal feuds escalating into lethal violence. Authorities have reiterated the importance of reporting threats and seeking legal intervention before conflicts turn deadly. This incident is under active investigation by the Dharamkot police, who are coordinating with neighboring districts to track down Inderjit Singh and bring him to justice while maintaining law and order in the area.

CM Sukhu Accuses BJP of Looting State Funds During Tenure

Shimla : Himachal Pradesh Chief Minister Thakur Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu today accused the previous BJP government of plundering the state treasury, spending lavishly, and neglecting long-term development priorities. Sukhu highlighted that the BJP received Rs. 54,296 crore in Revenue Deficit Grants (RDG) over five years, compared to Rs. 17,563 crore allocated to the current Congress government in the last three years. The Chief Minister pointed out that during BJP's tenure, RDG and GST compensation totaling over Rs. 70,000 crore were reportedly used for political stabilization and freebies rather than essential infrastructure and employee benefits. Sukhu emphasized that the BJP left behind a heavily indebted state with



total outstanding liabilities reaching Rs. 76,185 crore by the end of its term. He cited additional unfunded commitments from last-minute approvals of over 900 institutions, creating an annual liability of Rs. 5,000 crore, which the current government had to rationalize to prevent economic strain. In contrast, the Congress government has focused on healthcare modernization, investing Rs. 3,000 crore in state facilities and Rs. 1,300 crore under JICA Phase-II. The Chief Minister criticized BJP leaders for raising concerns about the state's fiscal position while ignoring their own record of mismanagement. Sukhu's statement underlines the stark contrast in fiscal management and policy priorities between the two administrations, framing the BJP's criticism as "hypocritical" given their past tenure.
