

THC-O/THC-P/DELTA 8/ DELTA 10



The cannabis plant is made of many cannabinoids, all of them but CBD having some level of intoxicating effect. Delta 9 is found at the highest concentration in the plant and easily extracted so it is considered naturally produced.

Delta 9 is regulated and monitored in state marijuana medical and recreational laws.

Unlike Delta 9 derived from a cannabis plant under the Federal Farm Bill of 2018, all naturally occurring Cannabinoids found in hemp (Isomers, derivatives, acids, salts, etc..), as long Delta-9 THC does not exceed 0.3% are Federally LEGAL. We can identify, extract, and sell these products in States that have not legalized Marijuana. This includes all other cannabinoids derived from hemp.

Hemp-derived delta-8 is legal in Illinois. The state permits the use, possession, sale, distribution, marketing, and production of delta-8 products. The same applies to other THC isomers, including delta-10, HHC, and THC-O. However, in March of 2022 it did prohibit production of Delta 8 from hemp plants, a controversial decision that has not been tested in the courts.

THC-O:

THC-O is chemically created by combining THC with acetic anhydride. It can produce intoxication equal to or greater than Delta 9. The high is euphoric and this is known as the "psychedelic cannabinoid".

THC-P:

THC-P is a new cannabinoid discovery that has very trace amounts in the cannabis plant. It is chemically stripped from the plant. It is being reported that THC-P has up to 10 times the intoxicating (euphoric) effect of Delta 9.

DELTA 8/10:

Currently, Delta 8 and 10 need to be chemically extracted from hemp plants, however, some companies are reporting high producing Delta 8 plants so they can claim natural production. Delta 8 produces a relaxing effect. Delta 10 produces a more energizing effect.

HHC, HHC-O, THC-V:

Many other cannabinoids are currently extracted from hemp based plants. HHC and HHC-O (Hexa hydrocannabinoid) is from the pollen and seed and creates a similar effect to Delta 9. THC-V needs to be taken in large quantities so is rarely used.

METHODS OF INGESTION:

Inhaling/smoking/vaping OR Ingesting (edibles)

COMMON SIGNS OF USE:

- Euphoria, relaxation
- Detachment, decreased anxiety and alertness
- Altered perception of time and space
- Laughter, talkativeness
- Depression, anxiety, panic, paranoia
- Amnesia, confusion, delusions, hallucinations, psychosis, short term memory impairment
- Mania
- Dizziness, lack of coordination and muscle strength

OVERDOSE EFFECTS:

- Hyperemesis: untreatable with nausea medication
- Fast heart rate progressing to slow heart rate
- Lethargy
- Slurred speech
- Low blood pressure
- Difficulty breathing
- Sedation/Coma
