Academic Impact:

Just over 88% of the district's ESSER III funds will be utilized to address the impact COVID-19 had on student learning. This includes:

- Certified RtI teacher
- ELA curriculum
- Multiple technology upgrades
- After school program and supplies
- Additional para professionals

Prevention/Mitigation:

Just under 12% of the district's ESSER III funds will be utilized for COVID19 mitigation. This includes:

- Salary for extra custodial staff
- Extra sanitation and safety and cleaning supplies
