Sessions cover topics from personal responsibility, finance, cultural issues, and respect for others to community service, health issues, communication, and college expectations. The men of the 100 and other volunteers provide mentorship to assist Beaus with defining future goals. Beautillion participants are also partially responsible for obtaining patron support for the Scholarship Fund. All net proceeds are directed toward scholarships and book awards which are distributed to the Beaus. Each beau receives a scholarship or book award, which can be used at the college or other institution of higher learning of his choice. I need your support on or before March 3. Can I count on you?
