

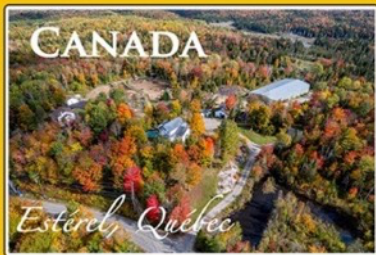



¹ Canine schools are not required for a companion dog but we do recommend them to have a wonderful well-behaved dog for a lifetime ☺. But should you experience some changes in your life, contact us! If you wish to evaluate the possibilities for a golden from our lineage to serve as a service dog or an ESA : evaluations can be done. Training can sometimes succeed (if your dog was trained before) and kits & ID can become available.

² – ESA dogs are usually not allowed in public transportation (but exception) nor in hospitals and sensitive public area. They can be tolerated in public shops and restaurants – but please be sure to respect the 3 golden rules in public: your dog can stay full time: respectful, clean, not jumping, not barking and never aggressive in public area – almost “like a furniture”. We also recommend a few lessons in Canine School.

³ Service dogs can access any public area. But note that to keep using the public service dog in training kit (tolerated for 4 months after purchase of the puppy) – then you will have to stay connected to a canine school : a few lessons are ok to keep fresh your puppy’s learning and you can keep training puppy at home if you have disposition for that. Please be sure to respect the 3 golden rules in public: your dog stays: respectful, clean, not jumping, not barking and never aggressive in public area - almost “like a furniture”. Note that access to *planes* require *Obedience Basic 3 Level* (obedience done at distance with signs, and / or no view, without leash). Hospitals could impose restrictions.

NOTE: Training costs can range from approximately \$1500 + tax per basic level (we recommend obedience levels 1, 2, then 3 for service dogs), and up to \$15,000 + tax for advanced training including transportation and learning specific commands (pickup dogs; DPT command for anxiety; detection (diabetes, etc.)). In all cases, you or a family member will need to be directly involved in the dog's training and daily exercises, either by participating in the training sessions or by continuing the exercises and training provided by your dog trainer/dog school at each stage, once the dog is at home. SECTION 4 | HEALTH WARRANTY & GUARANTEES

A. 40-Days Comprehensive Health Warranty

Every puppy is sold in good health. For 40 days from the date of departure, Service Dog Academy warrants the puppy against:

- Life-threatening or chronic conditions affecting vital organs (heart, lungs, kidneys, liver);
- Any condition that permanently and significantly impairs the dog's quality of life.

This warranty does NOT cover:

- Minor ailments (temporary diarrhea, vomiting, or skin reactions) during the adjustment period — this is normal within the first weeks in a new home;
- Any condition resulting from a diet change, trauma, accident, negligence, or failure to follow our care and feeding instructions;
- Any illness or injury arising after 60 days from departure (except the dysplasia warranty below).

B. 1-Year Anti-Dysplasia Warranty (Except for traumatic dysplasia caused by inappropriate routines)

Service Dog Academy provides a partial warranty against severe, debilitating hip or elbow dysplasia requiring surgery, valid for up to one (1) year from the date of sale. If surgery is required and confirmed by a licensed veterinarian, Service Dog Academy will contribute to improve the quality of life of your companion by participating to the surgery fees :

- Up to \$800 USD for dogs purchased above \$5,000 +tx or more;
- Up to \$400 USD for dogs purchased at \$1,000 to 4999\$+tx;
- Up to \$200 USD for dogs purchased under \$1,000+tx.

This contribution is paid directly to the veterinary clinic upon receipt of the official diagnosis and invoice. Service Dog Academy reserves the right to request a second veterinary opinion before any payment is made.

This warranty is VOID if the dysplasia is caused or worsened by:

- Traumatic accidents, falls, or impacts under the buyer's responsibility;
- Intense exercise inappropriate for puppy's age (no jogging, cycling, or rollerblading before 10 months of age);
- Overweight or obesity resulting from overfeeding.

C. Diet, Antiparasitic Products Warning & Warranty Conditions

IMPORTANT: To keep your warranty active, do NOT change the puppy's diet during the first 3 months at your home. Any dietary change when babies are in shock of transition can trigger severe gastrointestinal complications—which may be obliged vet to give excessive administration of medications and treatments, potentially leading to death or having severe

repercussions on the future quality of life of the puppy. Furthermore, such a change would result in the immediate voiding of our guarantees and a breach of contract—just as would the use of sarolaner, fluralaner or isoxazoline., active ingredients of **Nexgard, Bravecto, Simperica** and **Credelio** products. On our lineage, we have only used “**Simparica Trio**” (to treat also heartworms), when we have infestation of fleas/ticks with a strict monitoring for any reported adverse effects (allergies, anorexia, lethargy, vomiting, diarrhea, behavioral changes, seizures, strokes...) - stop and report the case immediately if so. *"According to Zoetis US, isoxazolines and their derivatives are associated with neurological side effects—such as tremors, ataxia, and seizures—in dogs, regardless of whether or not they have a history of neurological disorders. Other reports submitted to the FDA cite 400,000 cases of side effects (as listed above) and 15,000 deaths."* Recommended alternatives: Frontline, Advantage (spray / liquid tubs) and (expensive good) antiparasitic collars, are all fast-acting topical "spot-on" products to treat more safely. We provide 3 days of food at departure, and we provide pictures of our foods to help you provide the same. All transitions must be done gradually over at least 2 weeks by mixing progressively the foods (after 3 months). Contact us if needed : **(352) 502-1712**

SECTION 5 | NO-REFUND POLICY & EXCHANGE TERMS

IMPORTANT: Service Dog Academy does not issue refunds on the sale of any dog, for any reason. Purchasing a dog is a serious, long-term commitment. Please read this section carefully before signing.

A. Non-Refundable Deposit

The deposit (50% of the total price) is non-refundable under all circumstances, with one limited exception: if the buyer is prevented from proceeding due to a documented medical emergency, the deposit may be transferred to another buyer or applied to a future litter, at Service Dog Academy's sole discretion.

Allergy exception: Please come with all the family/ your partner before adopting to be sure there is not allergy nor problem with your project of adoption in your family. We will not be responsible, and consequences are terrible on any dog if so, refund will not apply. Also, if the buyer discovers another medical/humanitarian situation or a more complex allergy situation to dogs and if he provides a physician's certificate within 7 days of signing this contract, the reservation may be cancelled (but not the deposit). The deposit remains non-refundable. Buyers are strongly encouraged to spend time with Golden Retrievers before reserving.

B. One-Time Exchange Option

If a serious, life-threatening, or chronic condition is confirmed by a licensed veterinarian within 60 days of departure, the buyer may request a one-time exchange for a puppy of equivalent profile and value. This exchange:

- May only be used once per buyer;
- Excludes any refund or credit for training services received;
- Does not guarantee the same sex or coat color;
- Is subject to puppy availability and TPO qualification results;
- Supersedes and replaces all other claims or actions against Service Dog Academy.

C. Exceptional situations / Owner hospitalization / Return of Dog / Combating abandon

If the buyer is no longer able to keep the dog due to serious family or medical reasons (death, divorce, severe disability, or life-threatening allergy), they must immediately contact the Service Dog Academy. The dog may (potentially) be returned to us (we reserve the right to accept or decline), but at the buyer's expense and WITHOUT any possibility of refund or exchange. However, in certain cases of well-trained, healthy and good-behaved dog under 5yo, we may evaluate the situation to offer a 990\$ credit applicable toward the purchase of a future puppy (covering the full price of a basic puppy) when your situation may return to normal (may apply only in case of hospitalization if no family can help). This provision does not apply in cases of abandonment). The Service Dog Academy will endeavor to find a new home for the returned dog, acting in the dog's best interest, and to maintain contact; however, we cannot offer any guarantees nor assume any liability, regardless of the outcome.

Note that a rehabilitation penalty of \$500 USD may apply in the event of abandonment, breach of contract, or return of the dog for any non-medical reason. This penalty reflects the significant cost of rehabilitating a dog that has experienced separation trauma.

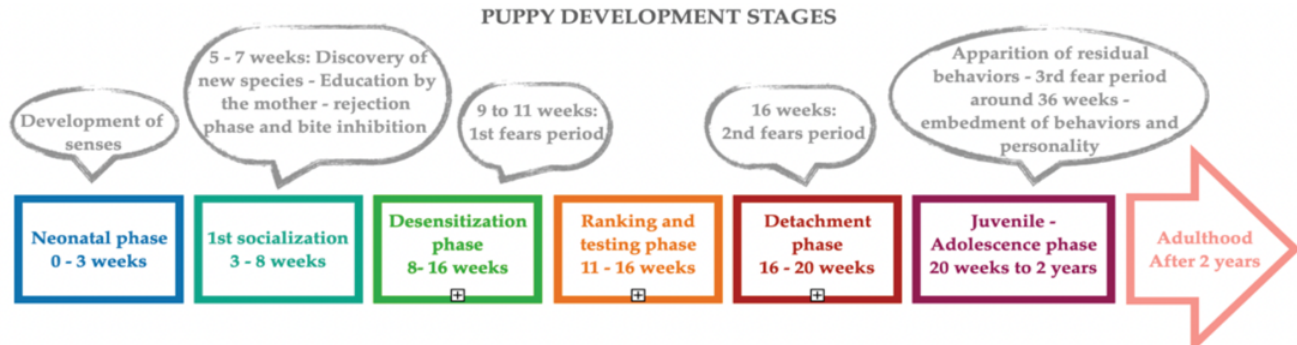


Figure 1 Timeline of the cognitive development of a puppy with three (3) sensitive periods of fear/ regression

SECTION 6 | BUYER RESPONSIBILITIES

A. Training

The buyer takes full and sole responsibility for the dog's training from the moment of departure. Service Dog Academy sells puppies with natural predispositions — not fully trained dogs. The buyer agrees to:

- Provide a minimum of two (2) x 15-minute obedience sessions per day for dogs under 2 years of age;
- Enroll in a certified dog training school or work with a professional trainer as soon as the dog arrives home;
- Understand that failure to maintain training may cause the dog to lose its acquired skills, for which Service Dog Academy bears no responsibility.

Important: Service Dog Academy cannot be held responsible for any loss of training, behavioral issues, or failure to qualify as a service or ESA dog resulting from insufficient training or changes in the home environment after departure.

B. Exercise Guidelines

For puppies under 10 months of age, intensive exercise is strictly prohibited. This includes jogging, cycling, rollerblading, or any sustained high-impact activity. Failure to respect this guideline may cause permanent musculoskeletal damage (OCD lesions, traumatic dysplasia) and will void all related warranties.

C. Sterilization

The buyer agrees to have the puppy sterilized before reaching around 1 year or 1 ½ year of age, unless medically contraindicated (or if any disturbing behavior changes occur). Proof of sterilization (signed veterinary certificate) must be submitted to:

Exception: Sterilization may be advanced if the dog displays hormonal behavioral issues requiring prior veterinary evaluation, such as urinary marking, escaping, possessive or dominant behavior, or if a special training requires the dog to focus.

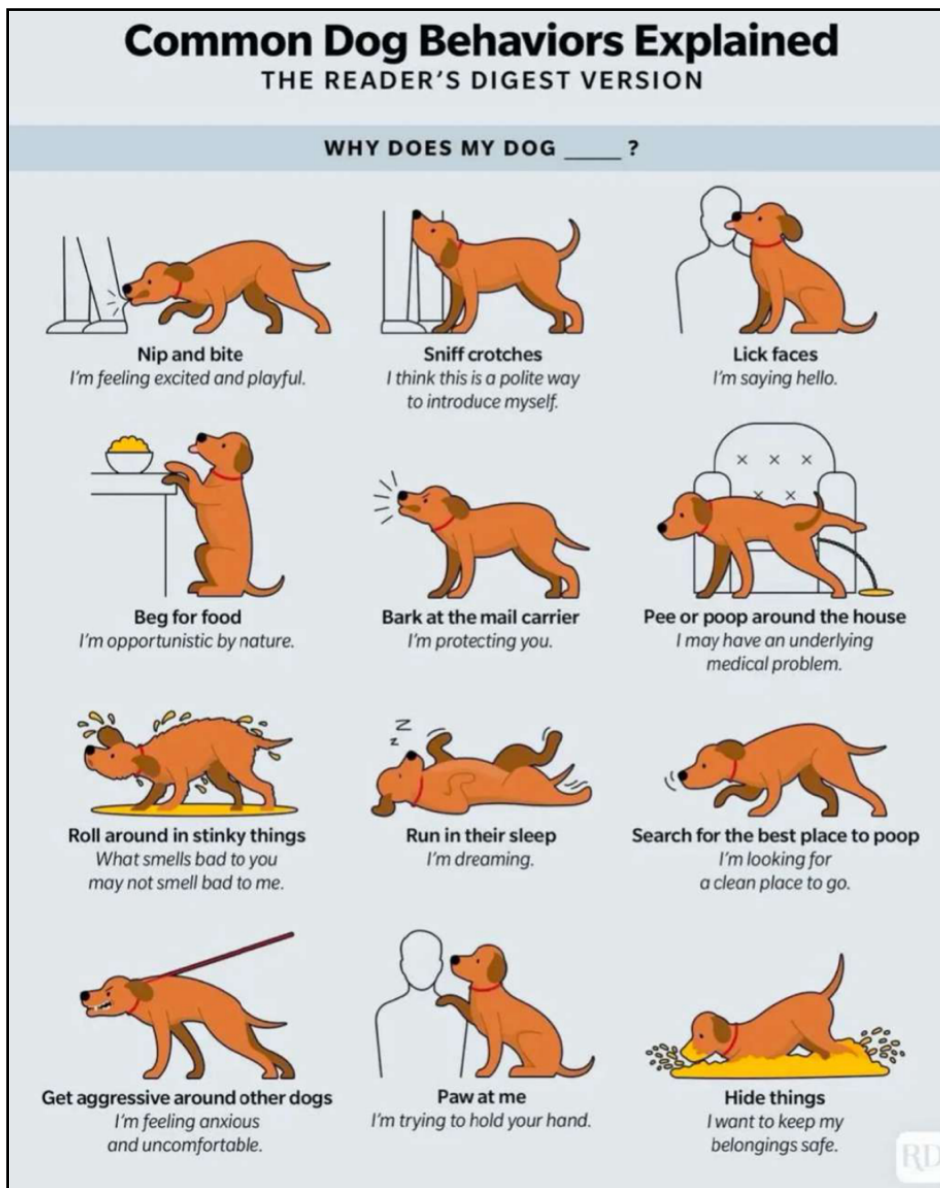
D. No Resale or Commercial Use

IMPORTANT: The resale, commercial breeding, exploitation, bad promotion or any trading activity involving this dog is strictly prohibited by this contract. Any violation constitutes a material breach of contract and may result in legal action.

SECTION 7 | LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

A. Service Dog Performance

Service Dog Academy does not guarantee that a dog sold with service dog or ESA predispositions will complete its full training or maintain its skills throughout its life. A dog's performance may be affected by trauma, illness, environmental changes, or insufficient ongoing training by the buyer. By signing this contract, the buyer acknowledges that a service or support dog is a complementary aid and does not replace professional medical care, nursing, or emergency intervention. Service Dog Academy is released from all liability for any failure of a dog to perform in an emergency or therapeutic context.



B. Full Responsibility After Departure

Once the puppy leaves our care and enters the buyer's home, the buyer assumes full and sole responsibility for:

- All accidents, injuries, incidents, or damage caused by or to the dog;

- All health consequences arising from diet changes, improper exercise, or environmental exposure (i.e. wrong food, medicines, or products he could eat or been exposed to, once at home);
- All behavioral issues resulting from inadequate training, unstable household dynamics, or inconsistent routines;
- Any omission or negligence in following the care instructions provided in this contract

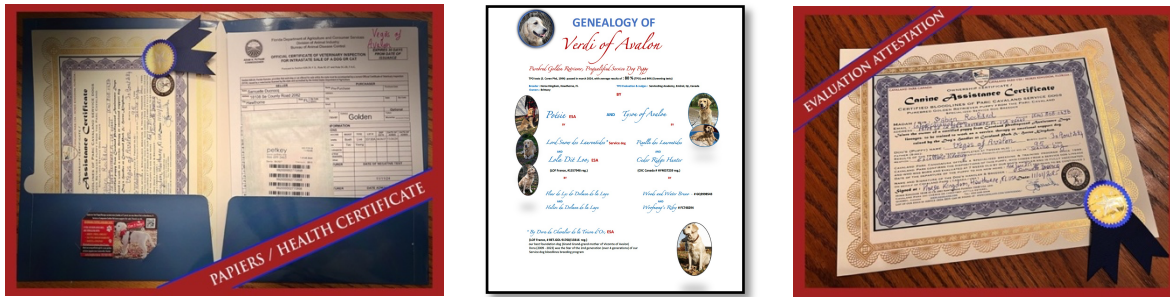


Figure 2 Your documents at departure : Certificate of lineage (pedigree) Microship & Health certificate

C. Veterinary Advice Disclaimer

Service Dog Academy is not a veterinary practice. Any guidance we provide regarding health, nutrition, or behavior is offered in good faith based on 27+ years of experience with our specific bloodlines and does not constitute licensed veterinary advice. Always consult your licensed veterinarian for all health and medical decisions.

Food

Here is the food to give (mix 2 or 3 of these) at home :
 You will find Next Level, Purina and Iam’s at Walmart, Diamond at Tractor Supply. We give 1 ½ mug at 8h30am and 1 ½ mug at 5:30 pm.
 Never change the puppy food before 3 months at your home ; give puppy food for the full first year, and kibbles must have meat as first ingredient. Give enough new fresh water, 3 liter/day.

We offer no warranty if you do not follow food instructions.



SECTION 8 | GENETICS, LONGEVITY & CARE GUIDELINES

A - Genetic Health Most of our dogs' parents have undergone DNA testing for over 267 hereditary diseases. Furthermore, some of them hold radiographic certifications from the OFA (Orthopedic Foundation for Animals)—a practice we have maintained across several generations of our bloodlines. Our lines draw upon two distinct pedigree registries spanning three countries (Canada, France, and the United States), allowing us to maximize genetic diversity and minimize the inbreeding coefficient, thereby fostering increased longevity. Consequently, the puppies will NOT be registered with the AKC or CKC, as these registries are generally closed to Golden Retriever bloodlines originating from other countries or continents, such as Europe.

But thanks to this bold genetic approach, we aim for an average life expectancy of 10 to 15 years for our dogs—a stark contrast to the longevity observed within many national registries (such as the AKC or CKC), where life expectancy tends to be on the decline, hovering around 8 or 9 years. Barring traumatic injuries, environmental factors, or improper dietary management, our bloodlines have consistently demonstrated excellent longevity since 1999. Many individuals from our 2 lines have lived without health limitations until the age of 12, and several others from 15 up to 16 years old, and now still alive; this is notably the case with Fougasse—my own father's Golden Retriever—who was born in Quebec (and appeared on television in 2010 in the attached commercial for FIDO mobile phones, alongside her brothers, Floyd and Freud). Fougasse remains in excellent health in Bordeaux, France, at the age of 16, and we regularly post videos of her. Vidéo (2010) of Fougasse, still alive at 16 yo en 2026 !

<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Y0AgoKQBgm8> **Nota :** Fougasse 'siblings (Freud and Floyd) also passed away at the ages of 14 and 15—exceptional results, the fruit of a harmonious combination of genetics, environment, healthy lifestyle, and a balanced diet.



B. Daily Care Recommendations

To ensure the best quality of life for your Golden Retriever:

- You must have a routine veterinary check-up once a year (required by contract).
- Fresh water available at all times (approx. 3 liters per day, replenished daily; remember to check your water supply—people tend to underestimate the quantity). If too much pee at night, stop water at 7pm/access at 7am
- Food: 1½ cups at 8:15 AM +1½ cups at 5:30 PM — feces follow after 15 minutes (with walk or playtime).
- 2 x 15-minute structured training or exercise sessions per day, combining play and obedience work;
- Maintain an optimal body weight — overweight dogs may lose 4 to 5 years of lifespan;
- No intense exercise (jogging, sports) once the dog shows signs of aging (white muzzle), typically from age 5-6;
- No travel without air conditioning in hot weather; protect paws on hot asphalt (above 27 C / 80 F);
- Do not leave an adult dog alone for more than 7 hours to protect kidney health ; never punish (you are late!).

C. Food Recommendations – various budget suggested, based on bags of 11-13 Kg

For the first year, we recommend mixing 2 of these foods according to your budget : Next Level Puppy food (Walmart) and various version of Next Level with Salmon or beef, as they offer 28 % of real meat protein (59\$); Diamond Puppy Food (Tractor Supply) (45\$), IAMS for Large Breed Puppies (57\$), Purina ONE for Puppies (lamb, beef or chicken variety) (68\$), or any brand recommended by your veterinarian where the first ingredient is meat (lamb, beef, salmon, or poultry preferred) like Royal Canin etc. (85\$). Vary the brand of food 2-3 times per year with a gradual transition to keep your dog stimulated by food and observe their feces or any side effects (we observe many allergies now with Poultries, stay alert!). Never give poultry bones (fatal choking risk). Stay with puppy food as the major part for the first year, and later, begin transitioning to senior-formula food from age 6 onwards.

<p>Whether or not I cover the costs of the training stages provided by SDA—and precisely because animals are sentient beings—I nonetheless understand that adequate training generally results in a level of success ranging from good to partial, and that it may occasionally fail. This is due to the numerous minor incidents, accidents, or even occasionally traumatic events that may occur at any point during the process and hinder the animal's full performance (fears may develop suddenly—for instance, if my dog is attacked by another, whether in a dog park, on a bus, etc.—particularly during the two critical "fear periods" of a puppy's cognitive development, occurring around 4 and 9 months of age); I am fully aware of this reality and accept it. I will adopt a dispassionate approach to guiding my Golden through his training in order to achieve better results without causing him anxiety (particularly during housetraining, or when the puppy takes time to master certain stages); furthermore, I will utilize substitution and diversion techniques to preserve his self-confidence and reinforce his learning. - I will NOT engage in intense exercise (jogging, cycling, rollerblading) with the puppy before 14 months of age.
