The doctor and/or the surgery center has the right to deny service for a second eye surgery if you are non-compliant with the first eye surgery.

Please understand that The Florida Lions Foundation for the Blind and our partnering physicians want the very best for your eye care so your goal must be the same by following their every instruction.
