Maternal Newborn and Child Health (MNCH) Program



In our relentless pursuit of better health and wellbeing, we've reached a significant milestone, distributing over I million doses of Albendazole deworming medication and essential prenatal vitamins to women and children in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and the Federal Republic of Nigeria.

By focusing on maternal and child health and ensuring access to vital nutrients, we aim to preempt lifelong health challenges in babies, including those stemming from inadequate placental development.

These interventions form the cornerstone of our commitment to enhancing maternal and child health outcomes, empowering families, and nurturing resilient communities across the regions we serve.


