

## LDEI Charleston Member Points

### Playing the Point Game

Members will earn points on a quarterly basis after an “audit” by the Board of Directors, and, for some categories, points can be accrued over time (if, for example, a member donates \$50 one month and \$50 the next, they will qualify for the points awarded for a \$100 donation). The awards will come in the form of an electronic sticker and overall points will be tallied by the Secretary.

A total of 100 points during a chapter year is necessary to remain an active member.

At the end of the chapter year, a prize will be given to the member with the highest points accrued, with a drawing to determine the winner in case of a tie.

Below are the point categories as well as who awards the points:

### Points/Awarding Entity:

#### Attendance - 10 points per meeting

- Attending chapter business meetings/Secretary
- Attending chapter educational programs held outside of business meetings/Secretary
- Attending fund-raisers held outside of business meetings/Treasurer
- Attending official chapter social events/Program Chair

#### Chapter Leadership

- Serving on board of directors – 40 points/President
- Serving as Committee Chair – 20 points/Board
- Serving as active committee member – 10 points per committee/Committee Chair
- Hosting educational or fundraising event – 40 points/Board
- Hosting official chapter social event – 10 points/Program Chair

#### Mentorship –

- Inviting, sponsoring and mentoring new members – 10 points per successful invitation/Membership

#### LDEI Engagement

- Attending LDEI Annual Conference – 20 points/Board
- Attending Council of Delegates session – 10 points/Board
- Participating in International Committee work – 15 points/Board

### Fundraising/Sponsorship

- Selling minimum number of tickets as determined per event – 20 points/Fundraising Chair
- Donating services or goods for LDEI event or obtaining sponsorship for equivalent value (\$100 minimum and can be accrued) – 30 points/Treasurer
- Donating money to LDEI chapter or obtaining sponsorship for equivalent value (\$100 minimum and can be accrued) – 30 points/Treasurer

### Misc

- Fully filling in skills survey for both international and Charleston chapter – 5 points/Secretary
- Above and Beyond – 30 points/by nomination from anyone, determined by Board

### **Beyond the Points**

A member who does not accrue the necessary 100 points will be asked to suspend membership for one chapter year before reapplying.

Charleston chapters may opt for a one-chapter-year membership leave of absence for major life events such as a birth, death, job change, etc.

Any member re-applying after a suspension or leave will be required to undergo the standard new member interview process to ensure they are familiar with any policy changes undertaken in their absence, although they will not be required to obtain a sponsoring letter from a current member.
