

Code of Conduct for Athletes

Integrate Play fosters a respectful atmosphere for skills development and play. As such, here are some fundamental expectations around conduct of our participants:

Respect for Teammates and Opponents:

Treat teammates with kindness and support, regardless of differences. Show respect towards opponents, acknowledging their efforts and skills. There is no tolerance for trash-talking or bullying behavior, both on and off the field.

Respect for Coaches:

Follow coaches' instructions during training sessions and matches.
Accept constructive criticism positively and strive to improve based on their feedback.
Avoid backtalk or arguing with coaches, instead, address concerns respectfully and at an appropriate time.

Fair Play:

Play by the rules and uphold the spirit of fair play at all times.
Shake hands with opponents before and after the game, regardless of the outcome.
Congratulate opponents on their successes and show empathy in defeat.

Communication and Conflict Resolution:

Address conflicts or disagreements calmly and constructively, seeking solutions rather than escalating tensions. Practice active listening and empathy to understand others' perspectives.

Commitment and Dedication:

Attend all sessions regularly showing commitment to the group. Be punctual and prepared for all team activities. Put in your best effort for personal and team excellence.

Any bullying, aggressive play or language, or disrespect of the coaches or other players will result in contact to parents/guardians to pick up their child, and non-refundable removal from the program.

By honouring this code of conduct, players help to uphold high standards for health and safety and contribute towards everyone getting the most enjoyment out of the sessions!
