# 5 things that define The Holy Spirit as a person.



# The Holy Spirit is a Person, not an "it"



The **Holy** Spirit is God - "**God is** spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth." John 4:24

### 1. The Holy Spirit has Purpose

His purpose: The Help and Comfort you. "Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you." John 16:7

# 2. The Holy Spirit has a Will

WILL; The quality of obstinately doing what one wants in spite of the wishes or orders of others.

"While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." Acts 13:2

"And they went through the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been forbidden by the Holy Spirit to speak the word in Asia. And when they had come up to Mysia, they attempted to go into Bithynia, but the Spirit of Jesus did not allow them." Acts 16:6-7
