2.	Why was Ananias hesitant to go to Saul?
3.	How did the other disciples initially respond to Saul after his conversion, and what challenges did the early church face in accepting former enemies?
ACTS 4.	What is the significance of Peter's vision of the unclean animals, and how did God use it to change Peter's mindset about the Gentiles?
5.	What kind of man was Cornelius, and why do you think God chose him as the first Gentile (non jew) to receive the Holy Spirit?
6.	How does the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on Gentiles in Cornelius's house confirm God's acceptance of all people through Christ?

7.	How did the Jewish believers in Jerusalem react to Peter's report about the Gentiles receiving the gospel?
8.	What role did Barnabas play in the church at Antioch, and what does this show us about the importance of encouragement and mentorship in ministry?
ACTS	12
9.	What does the church's response to Peter's imprisonment (Acts 12:5) teach us about the power of collective, persistent prayer?
10.	Why was Herod Agrippa I struck down by God, and what warning does this give about pride and seeking glory for ourselves instead of giving it to God?
