How to Serve with Excellence

- Excellence is not perfection—it is intentionality.

Learner’s Mindset

- Serving from **need** drains you.
- Serving from **vision** gives purpose, energy, and consistency.

Jesus didn’t lead from afar. He walked among the people.

- Learn names, listen to stories, build trust.

Jesus feeds the multitude – Mark 6

- How did they know they were hungry?
- How did they know a boy had loaves and fish?
