

DAY 8 – THE HOLY SPIRIT FILLS US WITH HIS LOVE

“And hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us.”

Romans 5:5 (NKJV)

The Holy Spirit is moving among us, filling us with life, love, and power. He is the promised Comforter, the guide who leads us into all truth, and the fire that purifies and renews.

This love also becomes a source of hope and strength for members of God’s family—In a world full of rejection, discrimination, hatred, and revenge, believers can be encouraged and renewed, empowered to stand firm in their faith in Jesus Christ. The love, joy, and peace we display can draw others to Christ, making us instruments in His hands for the expansion of His kingdom (2 Corinthians 5:20).

Our personal testimony is strengthened when we walk in tune with the Spirit, reflecting His light in every area of our lives
(*Philippians 2:15*).
