SET UP - BREAKDOWN and EVENT HOURS

The Ho'olaule'a will run from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday and from 10 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Sunday. A load-in load-out pass will be provided. The times are set by assigned booth number. For set-up and unloading, vehicles will be allowed in the staging area at 4:00 p.m. - dusk on Friday, Saturday and Sunday 6:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. ONLY ONE VEHICLE PER SPACE will be allowed inside the venue at any time. We ask for your cooperation during these congested times.

OVERNIGHT SECURITY

Vendors are not encouraged to leave merchandise in the booth over night. This a public park and security at night is not provided. HICCSC assumes no liability for any lost stolen or damaged merchandise.
