



#### STOCK CERTIFICATES

Stock Certificates are \$765.00 a share and may be purchased in full or over 5 years at \$153.00 a year.

#### DUES

All accounts must be paid by March 10th. If you choose, you may make two payments. The first half is due by March 10th with the balance due May 10th. Any balance due after May 10th will be assessed a \$25.00 a month fee, unless a monthly payment plan has been set up with the Club Manager prior to <u>May 10th deadline</u>. <u>If full payment is not received by June 15th, 2022</u> all golfing and social privileges will be revoked. A monthly automatic withdraw plan from your personal accounts is available by contacting the Club Manager when your account statement had been received.

#### RESIGNATIONS

Termination of membership requires a <u>written letter</u> to the Board of Directors by February 15th of the current year. A \$100.00 penalty will be deducted from your stock after that date, with exceptions to be determined by the Board.

#### SILVERCREST COUNTRY CLUB RENTAL RESPONSIBILITIES

At all private parties, refreshments, including food and beverage, may be furnished and served by employees or agents of the Club at fees to be established by the Club Manager, or may be catered in with Club Managers approval. The renter, upon presentation by the Club Manager shall pay these charges.

The renter shall be fully responsible for their guests for any damages to the premises. They must thoroughly clean up the premises after the party according to the arrangements made with the Club Manager prior to the event. They must remove all personal items and decorations from the premises. If the promises are not cleaned satisfactorily, the renter's deposit will NOT be refunded.

The renter shall notify the Club Manager regarding any special set-up requirements or special planning needs (example: chairs, tables, etc.). Although the plans are coordinated through the Club Manager, the renter is responsible for providing necessary "person power" to help move furniture and help in actual

set-up for the party.
