Meeting was called to order by Mayor James Sullivan at 6:00pm.

Roll Call:

Reading of May 14, 2026, minutes. A motion was made by Chad Pass and second by Donna McDougal approved as submitted.

Speakers:

Cindy Goings, resident of Lakeview Drive, spoke to council about the excessive speeders that are using Lakeview Drive as a cut through to avoid the roundabout. She would like 2 more installed and the 2 that are already installed need to be higher. And would also like to see more police presence. Officer Shawn Thompson spoke up and said he does not see this at night when he is on duty. Mayor James Sullivan will speak with Police chief Evans and ask them to patrol it more during the day.

Mayor James Sullivan addressed the citizens about the Facebook post and emails that were false statements that have been made about the park use and the Town of Cleveland will have to get with Coach Angelo.

Coach Angelo told the Town Council that he has about 33 children he trains Monday-Saturdays, He wants to keep the kids healthy and teach them about teamwork. He presented a detailed schedule training in AM and will only use 1 lane at the batting cages and will abide by rules and will leave field and cages cleaner than when he arrived.

Brandi Thomas addressed the Town Council that she only came to speak on behalf of Coach Angelo because her son takes lessons from Coach Angelo and got upset because of a misunderstanding about Coach Angelo using the park. Brandi stated there needs to be a process in place that does not favor anyone needs to be equal for everyone that uses the park.
