



Centerstage Children's Theater is excited to announce our first summer production, Moana Jr! Please read all the following information carefully to ensure that you have all the important details of this production.

There will be TWO casts of Moana Jr offered, both for children completing 3rd – 12th grade. Each cast will follow the same script, but may have variations with blocking, choreography, and props, due to director differences. Please carefully select the cast that will work best for you. All children who are registered will be cast in the show. Casts are kept small to ensure that each child gets maximum stage time. *However, due to the nature of this show, there will be some roles that are ensemble only.* Once casts are full, a waiting list will be kept in case of openings for additional children who are waiting to join.

Registration will be available for any actors who have previously participated in a Centerstage show or camp on **JANUARY 13 at 7:00 PM**. Any remaining spots will be opened to the public on **JANUARY 15 at 7:00 PM**.

This show will not have a meet a greet. All paperwork will be emailed out ahead of time, and parents will be asked to return it, filled out, on or before audition day. Due to this being a quick turnaround, each cast will rehearse twice a week.

Program Cost:

The program cost is \$250 per student. This can be split into 2 payments (\$125 due at registration, \$125 due at auditions) and can be paid via Venmo (@tanya-Bagwell) Paypal (Tanya_bagwell@comcast.net) or personal check (Centerstage Children's Theater – Mailed

This cost covers rental for rehearsal space, performance space, licensing, sets, props, scripts, t-shirts etc. Each actor is responsible for their own costume, and a suggestion sheet will be provided after auditions with ideas of how to make or purchase inexpensively. **Due to keeping the program small, this cost is NON-REFUNDABLE.**

Additional Information:

For each rehearsal, we ask that you send your actor with a bag containing their script, a full water bottle, a pencil and a highlighter.

Being a part of a show is a commitment. Due to smaller casts, no parts are double cast, and there are no understudies. Each actor is responsible for his/her part, and we will need every actor to put on our production. With a limited rehearsal schedule, we do not have time to reteach each scene multiple times. Each actor is allowed **ONE REHEARSAL CONFLICT** and we will need to be aware of what those conflicts are before auditions. Videos will be made of choreography taught during rehearsals, and it is expected that an actor who misses a rehearsal will watch the videos and come to the next rehearsal prepared. Tech rehearsals and performances are **mandatory**.

It takes a LOT of work to put on a production. Every actor is encouraged to have a parent that can volunteer in some capacity. We will need people to collect tickets, design programs, run sound/lights/projections, record our show, help build sets, help backstage and so much more! While we do not require parents to volunteer, we would like each parent to help in at least one area.

Centerstage Children's Theater is a faith-based company. We believe that all people are given abilities and talent from God, and we help to showcase some of these gifts on stage. Rehearsals will end in prayer (no child is ever forced to pray if they don't want to) and sometimes scripture may be shared. No religion or theology is taught, and everyone is welcome in our program, regardless of their beliefs.
