**Willamette Wanderers-40th Anniversary Walk**

This will be a self-guided walk without trail  
markings. But there will be a 5k & a 10K guided  
walk at 9:30am. Walk on paved sidewalks. Both  
routes focus on the 1989 10k walk designed by  
the Club which includes the State Capitol,  
Willamette Univ., Governor's Mansion, and the  
Bush Historic Residence

**Lava Trail Walk –(TGW)**

Clear Lake was formed 3000 years ago when  
lava flowed from nearby sand mountain and  
dammed the McKenzie River. This created a clear  
cold lake with maximum depth of 60 feet where  
you can still see petrified tree snags from long  
ago below the surface of the water. Beautiful  
views from the more than 5 miles on the loop trail  
around the lake. A great place for a nice get  
together and picnic in the shelter after the walk.

**July 4th Stroll thru History – Event**

Enjoy an Independence Day walk at the site of  
the oldest military fort in the Old Oregon  
Territory. Esther Short Park is the oldest public  
park in WA. Explore Historic Ft. Vancouver &  
Historic Uptown. Two 5 km loops. Group walk  
leaves at 9 am
