can apply for and from community donations!



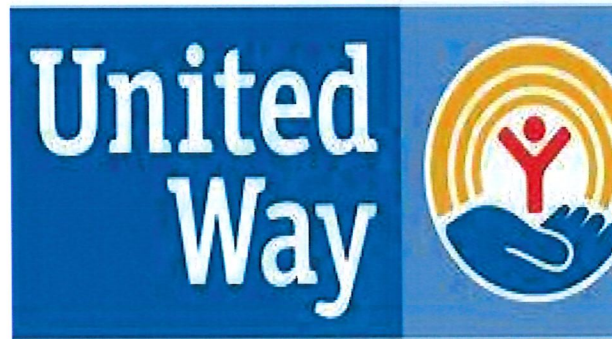
**Mid-Ohio Produce Markets** have all been moved to Mt Vernon as far as we know. As soon as we see any advertised, we will post it!

What happened at the center....

On Friday Feb 4<sup>th</sup> we received a call around midnight that our fire alarms were going off. Lisa came in to let COJFD in. After walking the building, it was realized there was water coming thru our ceiling and draining thru a smoke detector causing alarm. Saturday morning Eric Stover and Doug Flinn were contacted, and Lisa explained what had happened. When they came in, we had water coming down in all sorts of places along with ceiling coming down in our large Bingo room. Long story short the Insurance will pay for all the damages in the large room, but not for a roof. It was realized that some of our issues is the furnace in the attic is heating our attic and the ice dam we had encountered on Feb 4<sup>th</sup> was melting the ice causing water to run uphill under the shingles. Joe Myers at Air Plus sent out a crew for free and made needed repairs on furnace at no cost. Insurance does not consider the roof damaged, but our shingles were not properly put on according to Mike Brooks at Michael's Roofing & Gutter Company so he is trying to shave some cost, calling suppliers to get cost lowered, to see if we can figure out money to go ahead and put on a new roof, so we don't have this issue again. This all takes time so we are unsure of when we will reopen, but it is looking like sometime as early as April and as late as May at this point.

## **2022 Transportation Policy**

**This Policy takes effect April 1, 2022**

The Centerburg Senior Services Transportation policy will be as follows:

1. Effected April 1,2022 Centerburg Senior Services can only pay for two (2) transportations to a doctor appointment or therapy session each month.
2. The Client must call Centerburg Senior Services at (740) 625-5056 to schedule a ride to the doctor's appointment or therapy session. Please call as soon as the appointment is scheduled. CSS will contact Independency (Beth) for the scheduled appointment. Independency (Beth) will contact the Client to confirm or reschedule if needed.
3. If the Client calls and schedules the appointment directly with Independency LLC (Beth); the Client will be responsible for the invoice.
4. Centerburg Senior Services will not be able to pay for any transportation for an outpatient surgery or procedures.
  - a. The reason for not covering outpatient surgery or procedures is because of the wait time. Centerburg Senior Services is charged by the hour, and we do not have funds to cover the day.
5. If the Client has a surgery and there is follow up visit needed due to the surgery CSS will cover the follow up visit. This will not count towards the two (2) rides.
6. IMPORTANT- if you cancel the day of your doctor appointment and/or therapy session three (3) in the year; you will not be able to schedule any other rides for the rest of the year.
7. IMPORTANT – There is no guarantee of a private ride service. CSS does not provide a one-on-one ride service. You may be sharing a ride with other seniors.

For the Clients that need additional rides each month KAT is available to you at a low cost. Clients must call KAT at 740 392-7433 to schedule and pay for their rides.
