I have been asked when food bags will go out. Food bags are called Blizzard bags and go out to all current Meals on Wheels clients during the winter months when bad weather is being called for. These bags are meant to go into a pantry and on the days we cannot deliver a meal we know you will be ok with the food we sent.

During 2020 Covid outbreak and the center was closed we changed the blizzard bags to be Covid food bags to help people out because we received extra funding.
