



Legal Aid of Southeast and Central Ohio is organizing a free legal clinic on January 21, 2026, from 10 AM to 1 PM at The Station Break Senior Citizens Center in Mount Vernon, Ohio. This event is designed for low-income adults aged 60 and above. Attendees will have the opportunity to consult with an attorney to prepare simple wills, financial and medical powers of attorney, and transfer-on-death affidavits for real estate owners.
