Greetings MMCC Members,

Vickie and I are pleased to bring you the latest update of what's happening at NCM and the Corvette World. Lots of new and exciting things happening as you will see in this issue. Personally, we are preparing for a road trip to the Museum for the 2025 Annual Ambassador Academy where we sharpen our skills, coordinate with other clubs and get a total briefing for all things Corvette and attend Vets N Vettes which honor the great men and women of our nation's veterans.

1. GM & Corvette Production — “Numbers Don’t Lie”



- GM has officially revealed that the 2025 model-year Chevrolet Corvette lineup amounted to **25,835 units**.
- Breakdown by model:
 - Stingray Coupe: 8,403
 - Stingray Convertible: 5,237
 - Z06 Coupe: 4,786
 - Z06 Convertible: 4,076
 - E-Ray Coupe: 1,374
 - E-Ray Convertible: 1,779
 - ZR1 Coupe: 115; ZR1 Convertible: 65
- The production total was further highlighted in coverage by The Auto wire.
- What this means: the mainstream Stingray still carries the bulk of volumes; the halo ZR1 remains rare and exclusive.
- Also relevant: the October 2025 order-cycle constraints for Corvette were released, revealing what dealers & customers are facing now.

Takeaway for you: If you've got interest in a 2025 Corvette — especially a Z06 or ZR1 — knowing the production split and ordering constraints gives you insider knowledge.

Remember when the announcement of the C8 Mid-Engine car was introduced? Lots of speculation and resistance. Well now over 196,000 cars have been made.

General Motors has wrapped production of the 2025 Corvette model year, and the official production statistics released by the National Corvette Museum reveal a fascinating breakdown of how the 25,835 examples were distributed around the world. 2. Corvette Racing & Pratt & Miller Motorsports — Championship Sweep!





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- At the iconic 10-hour Petit Le Mans (Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta) the team behind the #3 Corvette Z06 GT3.R (drivers Antonio Garcia & Alexander Sims) clinched the Drivers' Championship, the Teams' Championship, and the Manufacturers' Championship for Chevrolet in GTD PRO.
- A season review published on October 22 highlighted how consistent the Corvette effort was and that Corvette has “ascended back to the top” in 2025 after a few years of strong competition.
- Qualifying setups were tight: on October 10 the No. 4 Corvette Z06 GT3.R qualified on the second row ahead of Petit Le Mans.

Why this matters: Corvette isn't just building fast cars—it's proving them in endurance racing. The racing success feeds brand prestige and reaffirms performance creds that trickle into road cars.

3. National Corvette Museum & Corvette Campus Updates





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- The National Corvette Museum announced on October 14 that it will build a new **66,000-square-foot Collections facility** to preserve historic Corvettes and artifacts. Opening is slated for Fall 2026.
- The expansion is underway and will include vehicle preservation labs, small-artifact conservation space, long-term storage, and importantly **behind-the-scenes tours** for enthusiasts and historians.
- In late September the Museum delivered its **20,000th Corvette** through its R8C Museum Delivery program — a Sebring Orange 2026 Stingray.

Note: This is big for the Corvette community — growing the museum’s capacity ensures that more Corvettes (and stories) will be preserved for future generations. Plus, the milestone delivery shows the demand from enthusiasts remains strong.

4. NCM Insurance Agency – Coverage That’s More Than Just Skin Deep



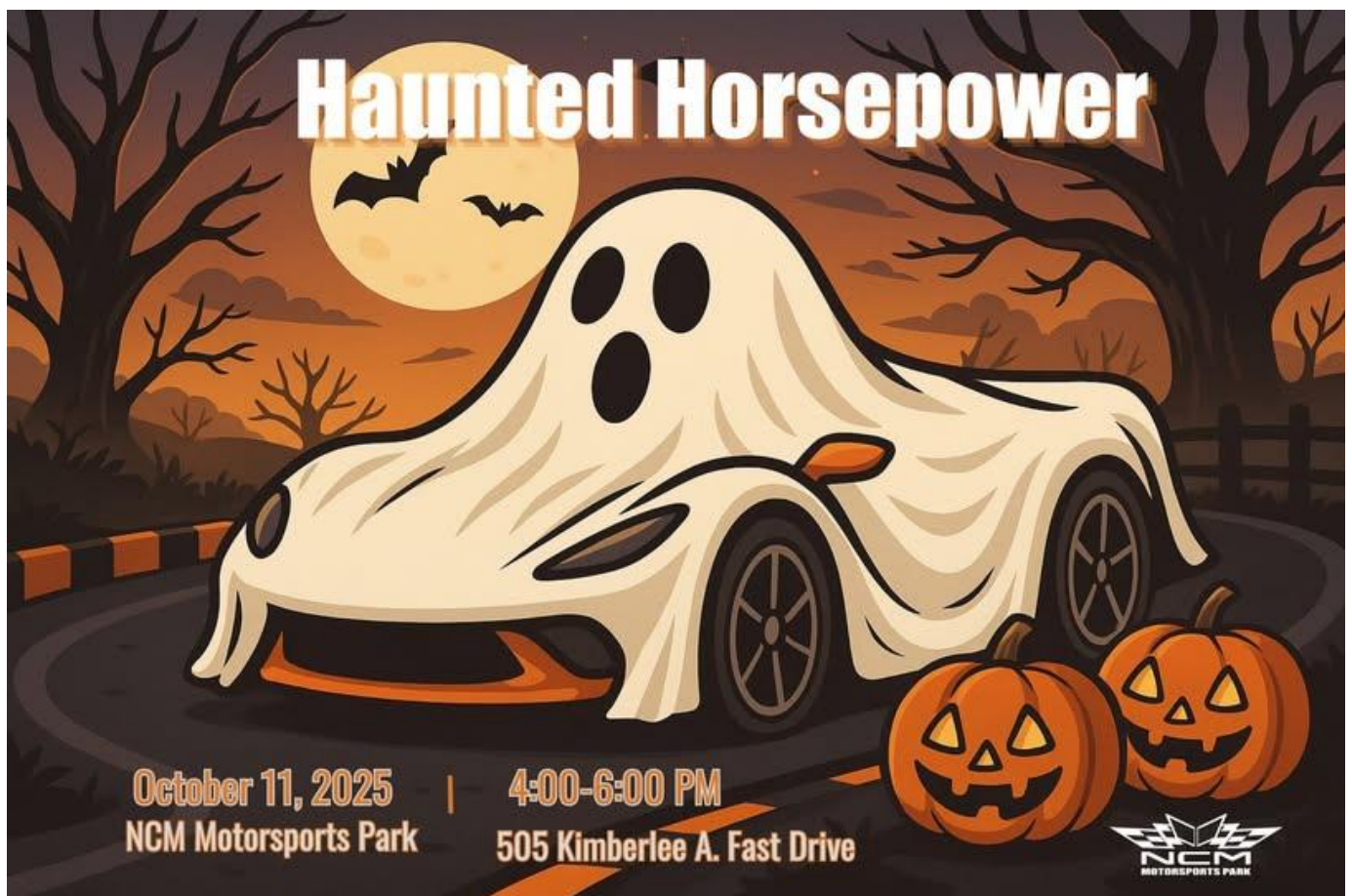


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- On October 8, NCM Insurance announced a **new perk**: relocation reimbursement for collector vehicles. If you move your car ahead of a natural disaster (or similar risk) they'll cover up to 50 % of your relocation expenses — max \$200 per vehicle.
- They continue to emphasize their collector-vehicle niche: offering "Agreed Value" policies (you and the underwriter agree up front how much the car is worth) and other tailored coverage.

Why it's useful: Owning a Corvette (especially a classic or limited edition) isn't just about driving—it's about protecting an asset. This kind of policy detail may be something you want to check out if you're in the market.

5. NCM Motorsports Park – Events, Track Days & Family Fun





- On October 11 the park hosted its “**Haunted Horsepower Trunk-or-Treat**” event — a Halloween-season twist with decorated Corvettes, candy giveaways, family-friendly fun and community partner displays.
- Also happening mid-October was the “Final Lap” event (Oct 17-19) organized with NASA Midsouth at the track: offering HPDE (High Performance Driver Education), time trial and wheel-to-wheel racing.

Why this matters: Whether you own a Corvette or just love them, the motorsports park offers direct access to the driving side of the experience: track sessions, family-friendly events, and community engagement.
