Corvette Cup: Russ

- 102 cars were registered for the 2026 Cup.
- Profit was increased from last year's Cup and the majority will be given to the Dream Factory now. In the 4th quarter another donation will be made if funds are available.
- Per the Van Houten's, it now costs \$8000-10,000/dream according to the Dream Factory. The Dream Factory also mentioned making a banner with the club and Dream Factory logos. The Dream Factory is looking for volunteers.
- It was voted and approved to contribute to the National Corvette Museum. It will be presented to the NCM at the club's visit in June. The club's name will be added to the NCM wall.
- 2027 Cup registration is now available on the club's website. The Isle of Capri rooms can be reserved for a discounted rate with CARSHW2 once it is working correctly.

License plate proposal: Russ

- 85 signatures of the 200 required are currently on the petition.
- A state representative, possibly Tim Taylor, is needed to sponsor the bill.
- The club fee for the license plate was discussed and will be discussed further at a later meeting.
