Opening in Fall 2026, the new Collections Facility is a strategic investment guided by donor support, museum stewardship, and Corvette pride. Behind every square foot is a commitment to preserving America's Sports Car.

Project Naming Opportunities

Vehicle Collections Gallery \$1,000,000

Responsible for housing the National Corvette Museum vehicle collection, the Vehicle Collections Gallery will hold up to 250 Corvettes spanning nearly 40,000 square feet, using state-of-the-art preservation techniques to ensure they can be viewed, exhibited, and researched for generations to come.

Lobby and Tour Reception \$500,000

All Vehicle Collections Gallery tours will begin in this two-story, open-concept space, which every visitor will pass through. This area is also available for rental and may be reserved for small, private events.

The Preservation Center \$350,000

The preservation team at the National Corvette Museum is responsible for all aspects of vehicle care, from preventive maintenance to body-off conservation efforts. We strive to keep all our vehicles in the same mechanical condition as when they were first produced, and the Preservation Center is where this work will be done.

3D Artifact Storage \$250,000

The diverse collection of the National Corvette Museum goes far beyond automobiles. The several hundred objects within the 3D artifact collection showcase Corvette's scope and influence on the world from 1953 to today. This area will not only safely house these objects to the highest preservation standards but also provide the physical and intellectual control that was not previously possible.

Conference Room \$200,000

A versatile conference room designed for collaborative meetings and working sessions, supporting the Museum's collections team and exhibition planning.

Heritage Conservation Lab \$175,000

Having a controlled environment to safely intake objects and prepare them for long-term artifact storage is a critical part of the collections process. The Heritage Conservation Lab will allow collections professionals to catalog and house objects as soon as they enter the building, creating a more efficient and accurate workflow.

These naming opportunities represent a meaningful way to create a lasting legacy while supporting our mission. Each naming commitment will have a lifespan of 25 years. At the conclusion of the 25-year period, naming rights may be renewed through mutual agreement, ensuring flexibility for both parties while maintaining the integrity of our recognition program.
