One of the most exciting stops was the NCM Motorsports Park. Upon arrival, members observed preparations for a private endurance racing event taking place later that weekend. The atmosphere was electric, and it didn't take long before our group had an opportunity to experience the track firsthand.

Following the driver's briefing, members participated in parade laps around the circuit.
