- 3. What strengths stand out in the classroom?
- 4. What supports are already in place, and how well are they working, how do we know they are working?
- 5. How do we know if my child is making progress and is that adequate?
- 6. What can we do at home that reinforces classroom goals?
- 7. What next steps would you recommend if progress isn't where it should be?
