*Between 1972 – 1978 New England College students were required to complete 30 courses to graduate. Each full-semester course was worth four credits and was listed on the student's transcript as "1". Physical Education courses were one credit each, and were recorded as ".50".

MERGER WITH NEW HAMPSHIRE INSTITUTE OF ART (NHIA)

New England College merged with the former New Hampshire Institute of Art on July 1, 2019. New England College has assumed custodianship of the academic credentials issued by New Hampshire Institute of Art. All New Hampshire Institute of Art credit bearing courses appear on New England College transcripts. For students enrolled after 7/1/2019, credit will be included on the transcript as Transfer from New Hampshire Institute of Art with grades and GPA information.
