CCDI Launches Start Smart September 2025 to Support Children Returning to School in Karu, Nasarawa State

Abuja, Nigeria – Tuesday, 16 September 2025 – Create that Change Development Initiative (CCDI) has launched its annual *Start Smart September* back-to-school programme, aimed at supporting boys and girls in public primary schools from low-income communities in Karu, Nasarawa State.

Now in its second year, this impactful initiative is designed to reduce the barriers that prevent children from accessing education. This September, a total of **65 pupils from six public primary schools** will benefit. Each child will receive:

- Full payment of the PTA levy for the school year
- One set of school uniform
- One set of sportswear
- Sandals
- Sports shoes
- Two pairs of socks
- A school bag
- A water bottle
- Exercise books and stationery

Speaking at the launch, **Mrs. Sharon Ayeni, Executive Director of CCDI**, reaffirmed the organisation's commitment: "It is the right of every child to have access to education. Through initiatives like this, CCDI is helping to break down the barriers that keep children from school."

This intervention aligns with Nigeria's national agenda on education, particularly efforts to reduce the number of out-of-school children and improve learning outcomes in underserved communities.
