MPR Member's of the Month

The HODDY Quirk Family

Our dad, Harrison "Hoddy" Quirk of Ypsilanti Michigan was a Prop Rider starting in the late 1950's or early 1960's. Hoddy, and his wife Dee, raced the 48 cubic inch class in the "Honk" in the 1960's, a front engine Ingram Hull. He was instrumental in starting the Ypsilanti races on Ford Lake that ran for a number of years. In the 1970's, the class changed to the 850 cc class, and Hoddy bought a Ron Jones cabover named the "Miss Muff" and ran a Sunbeam Imp engine. He won the Nationals at Dayton in 1973. He bought a second Jones cabover in 1982, called "Hoddy's Quirk", which he raced until 1995, and then it was vintage raced from 2005-2011.

Hoddy's son Matthew still has Hoddy's Quirk (Hoddy and Dee passed away in 2017) and the boat ran for the first time since 2011 at Wheeling, West Va. in 2023. We are attending the Decatur, IL Race in June 2024, and hope to make it to other races in 2024. Matthew raced Hoddy's Quirk some in the 1980's. His brother, Preston Quirk raced J Stock hydros in Region 6 from 1968-1973. Today, Matthew and Preston alternate driving the vintage race heats. Lisa Quirk, Hoddy's daughter, also is active at the vintage races assisting as part of the pit crew, frequently helping to dry the boat and mop up the Kendall 50 weight oil that a modified Imp engine always seems to spew out in most heats.

The Quirk family has been active in boat racing since Hoddy built his first boat in 1948, and are still active today, after 76 years!
