Called to order by john Grigg at 7:31

Welcomed Mrs. Kathy Richards, round of applause. Moment of silence for Royce Richards and Ron Jones, Jr. Motion to accept general meeting minutes as printed, Rick Falcinelli, 2nd - Connie LaBelle. All in favor Motion to accept the board minutes as printed, Tina Wilson, 2nd - Adam Justin, All in favor

Treasurer Report: Mario 3 expenses. Mario pointed out that Royce Richards was treasurer before him. Motion to accept Treasurer's Report, Rick Falcinelli, 2nd – Brian Reed. All in favor

Membership: 112 members

Publicity: Tina said this is the last month she will remind people for Bios.

Entertainment: Ray introduced Chris Misiak, a culinary chef, from Schoolcraft College. Chris presented Ray with a birthday gift and a chef apron.

Old Business:

Prop Cover rule is delayed until 2025 but recommended for 2024. John Bridge had questions because the rule is on the inspector's test.

Race Committees: Mott Lake is moving forward. In sponsorship mode. Patti suggested that if you have connections for possible sponsorships, please pursue.

Pontic Lake: They would like the race the weekend before Memorial Day 2025. Looks like things are progressing.

Walled Lake: Tina and Jim Wilson opened the door back to this race. City may be tough. Will be a 2025 event.

Genesee County Day – covered for boats. Need some for Touch A Truck. Would like to have different classes represented. They want the full display that was at Autorama. There will be lots of kids present. Wilson and Falcinelli will have theirs at Touch A Truck.

New Business:

Genessee Event: John requested a vote for up to \$250 for Scooter for coloring supplies and travel. Motion to approve by Rick Falcinelli, 2nd by Rich Falcinelli. All in favor.

Patti handed out a volunteer sign up sheet for Mott Lake for everyone to sign up for. Tina suggested that assignments be handed out by class.

Phil talked about Hot Boats. Mark weber was in favor. One member of Hot Boats brought the boat to Test and Tune and Mike Noonan and Chris Ritz went over it and told them things that they need to work on to be able to participate. Made contact with Robin Shane and needs info from them to see how to proceed. They are not a fan of the oval course, would rather make drag runs down the front stretch and putt up the back stretch. Dave asked about drones. Phil explained the insurance expectations for drones. There were questions regarding the use of turn judges with drones. Some feel the necessity of using both turn judges and drones.

Still looking for sponsorships. Steve Read is assisting with sponsorships. Dave will email the list of people that he has contacted. Phil is working with Bobby Keys.

Website: Scooter said he and Brian finished the website. It is now .com. Scooter owns .org and .net. Got mailchimp to work again. Facebook numbers are way up. Scooter is working on a drop box and other things. Working on stuff to help promote

Touch A Truck for Genessee County. With everything he did he came in just under budget. Nancy thanked Scooter for getting mailchimp to work and Scooter said that the thanks goes to Brian. Tina questioned the journey of the newsletter, who she sends it to, where it goes from there, etc... Scooter said he would keep Tina updated.
