Race Reports.

New Business:

Mott Lake- The park commission voted to approve the race for 2024.

Reiterated from last month, they are in the fundraising phase. The Chamber of Commerce emailed about an event at Huckleberry Railroad at the park. The event is July 6 and 7, 2024 from 10am to 5pm. They invited the MPR to display a boat at the event. This currently is the biggest annual event at the park. Good opportunity to promote the Regatta. Pontiac Lake- Nothing new.

Ray reported that Lee is sending out notices for the volunteers for this years Gold Cup race August 23rd, 24th & 25th. Steve Fischel reported that they are putting the Y93 together and would like John to be the test pilot.

Motion made to adjourn by Dave Muczinski, seconded by Patti Hayes at 8:29pm.

Discussion: followed regarding racing in the area.

People have been inquiring about renting the Equipment Trailer Rental. Need to set the coast for rental of the trailer and the cost of a damaged/destroyed buoy.

Discussion:

Phil Goodell made a motion that MPR would charge \$1500 for trailer rental to an outside region, and \$250 for any damaged or destroyed bouys. Tina Wilson seconded the motion. All in favor.

John passed around the list of items included in the trailer and stated that it does need to be updated.

John discussed insurance for the trailer. Said we need to know who will be towing it because it will be a rider on someone's policy. Discussion followed regarding insurance.

Dave Stefaniak and Mark Funk of Michigan Hot Boats were present and would like to join up with us to be able to race. They are trying to figure a way to run their boats in a safe manner. Need to speak to APBA about how to do special events. Phil discussed getting a meeting with them to talk more in depth. They get about 12-15 boats right now, but are hoping to pull in about 25.

Scooter – Website: New website is going. Everyone looked at the website. Talked about how it can now be used to get sponsorships, etc.... Explained that the Teams page with not have all of the information one every team, but will have a link to each team's page. Front page will also house any race site sponsors. Will run high promotion for race sponsors as we get closer to a race weekend.

Facebook and Instagram is skyrocketing. The website will be linked to our original .com link soon. Scooter already has all of the .com, .net, .org names under his ownership. Scooter did not delete anything from old website. Will keep one year of files on website, rest will be kept in files somewhere else so that we always have past information.

Discussed: not putting a newsletter on the website for 2 weeks. There was some discussion regarding the way Mailchimp works.

John pointed out that Scooter is the Social Media Committee Chair and the committee also includes Austin Hayes and Sara Grocki.

A look back "The Man of Generosity and Friendship"

R. Royce Richards

November 18, 1932 To April 10, 2024

Royce was born in Detroit, he attended Western High School and was part of the ROTC program, graduating in 1951. The next year, he set off to defend our country in Korea, achieving the rank of sergeant (T) at 19 years of age(E6 Staff Sgt., 45th Infantry Division) ! He was so proud of his service and honorable discharge, although what he experienced there followed him throughout his whole life.

Returning home in 1954, he went to work back at his fathers company, Don Cartage in Detroit. After his father stepped down Royce took over until the company closed in 2000.

Royce married his sweetheart Kay Frazio in August 1973 and began their life together residing in Troy, Michigan.

Although Kathy was always the love of his life, there was another or many other loves. "Hydroplane Racing" and the clubs he belonged to. He got interested at the age of 17 when his Dad's company provided the cranes for the Unlimited Races, his interest was in the boat named "Eager Beaver". The first hydro he purchased himself was a Y boat that he bought in 1958. His next boat was a Lauterback 225 N-52 known as "Fat Chance" he sought it and brough it back to new throughout the 1990's.


Royce was a legendary figure in the Hydroplane world:

Three North American cups Several Interstate Division Championships Course Records Numerous World Records Marine Prop Riders High Points (First to win it) First Place Finishes Prop Rider of the Year (MPR) I'm sure there are many more....

Royce also was on the advisory board if the Spirit of Detroit Thunderfest Gold Founding member of the Regatta Association Sponsor of Quake on the Lake

Royce was a fixture in our club, he and Kathy where always there to lend a helping hand or make super donations to our club and anyone else that needed it. There isn't a sole in our universe that can be replaced, but in my opinion Royce would be a hard act to follow. According to Kathy he left this world asking :

"Who needs our help today"


